Welcome to week 6 of ISL. On paper this looks like one of the toughest rounds of the season and plenty to play for as we hit the business point of the season.

After an owners vote the following rule has been included into the ISL By-Laws: **If a drafted player withdraws from the ISL competition they can be replaced under the following circumstances:**

1. The owner must be able to verify that the player will not be returning and it is their decision to withdraw (remembering the players did pay upfront their money).
2. The owner must propose the player they are requesting to replace them with along with full details of the players background
3. The request will then be sent to all team owners (all owners will have 1 vote and it must be the owner who replies, they can obviously consult with whoever they like, they will be the only ones who are eligible to vote for the simple reason that they are the people putting up the money. The owner will respond privately to me with their answer which will remain confidential.
4. 80% or more of opposition owners must support the new proposed player. So this is minimum of 4/5 in the women or 8/10 in the men.
5. Any owner who does not reply within 48 hours will be considered to be in support of the new player proposal.
6. There is no appeal process if the player is not approved, they will not be eligible to replace that player.
7. Each team can have a maximum of 2 approved replacements for the season (bearing in mind each team has a spare and blood uniform) but may have as many replacement proposals as they wish.
8. The player must pay a pro-rata cost for the season (\$165.00 divided by 10, multiplied by number of regular season rounds remaining and the player must also register with Gold Coast Basketball / second association if they are not already).
9. The application for the replacement player must be received by no later than 5pm on the Wednesday prior to the game they wish to play in.
