How fast the first half of our 2011/12 season has gone. We are now into the busy part of our season with nipper carnivals on most weekends. January 2nd we held an extra MMLSC carnival style nippers session. A fantastic morning was had by all. We originally had planned a 4.30-6pm session however due to the forecast of the day to hit around 40degrees we ran it in the morning from 9.00- 11. We had amazing feedback regarding this day from nippers, parents to Age Managers. People further down the beach were curious so came up to see what was happening. And guess what? Yes they have decided it would be fantastic for their children to partake in this fantastic, fun activity called NIPPERS at MMLSC.

You know the thing that makes our club the best is the dedication our parents put into making our club what it is today, and if not for you it would not be possible. We had a nipper's carnival at Cosy Corner on Friday January 6th another great day and Mt Martha LSC was well represented with 52 competitors. Our U13-U14 competed at Anglesea January 8 and Saturday 21st January was 5th Melbourne carnival. Wooooo what a blustery windy day however that did not deter 36 of our kids from u8 –u12 competing. Warrnambool is Saturday 28th January. We have 22 keen nippers registered for this carnival. Sunday 5th February is Regionals at Pt Leo. The cut off date for registration is 23rd January if they are wishing to compete. Pt Leo Regionals carnival is for U8 –U14. U8 can compete at all carnivals EXCEPT the Victorian State Championships at Lorne.

Pt Leo Regionals is where our TEAMS U9-U14 wishing to compete at States are required to compete and if successful, qualify for the Vic Championships on the weekend of 3-4 March at Lorne. Saturday 3rd March is individual events where all children can compete. Sunday 4th March is for teams only that qualified at Regionals at Pt Leo. We always have an outstanding amount of competitors representing MMLSC, last year around 80 of our nippers and families travelled to Lakes Entrance for a great weekend.

Registrations for Victorian State Champs cut off are 18th February. Most families have already booked accommodation months ago, so if you are considering attending and have not booked in anywhere I would suggest trying to find somewhere ASAP. Our State Team will also receive a MMLSC States team top at minimal cost so to assist us in correct amount to order please register ASAP.
