WORLD RECORDS

Obadele Thompson from Barbados ran **10.08** in El Paso, USA on April 16 to lower the Junior World Record of 10.09 held by the USA's Mel Lattany. First reports indicate that it will not be ratified as a WJR as there had been no dope-testing. Later reports that this was done and it should go ahead to get the I.A.A.F. nod.

On the same weekend in Walnut, California at the Mt SAC Relays, the Mighty Santa Monica Track club turned in two fast relay times within the space of about two hours.

Michael Marsh, Leroy Burrell, Floyd Heard and Carl Lewis ran 37.79 for a US All-Comers Record for the 4 x 100m and then clocked **1:18.68** to break their own 4 x 200m World Record.

In the 4 x 200m the anchor runner on the 2nd placed team (John Regis - UK) was gaining on Lewis the whole way and had an unofficial split of 19.1 We will see what form he is in come the Commonwealth Games, but that surely is an exciting start to the season for him.

Bo Lingtao (China) broke Sweden's Stefan Johansson's 20km track walk record of 1:18:35.2 with a timing of **1:18:03.3** at the National Stadium in Beijing.

On the same day (7th April) in the same stadium Gao Hongmiao (China) broke Nadezhda Ryashkina's (Russia) 1990 record of 41:56.23 when she walked **41:37.9**

On May 7th, in Fana, Norway, Bernado Segura (Mexico) broke Bo's one month old record when he covered the 20km on the track in **1:17:25.5**

On the same day the 50km track walk record of Raul Gonzales (Mexico) fell to France's Rene Piller who cover the 125 laps in **3:41:28.2** (Oh to be a lap scorer on that race!)

Late news of two World Records has come to us courtesy of Mel Watman's *International Athletics News Service*.

Haile Guebre Silassie (Ethiopia) ran **12:56.96** to break Said Aouita's (Morocco) record for the 5000m.

Olga Kuzonkova (Russia) broke her own W.R. in the H.T. when she tossed the 4kg hammer **66.84m**.

Actually there will be no official W.R. until the end of this year when the I.A.A.F. will bestow World Record status on "the best performance achieved under World Record conditions as at 31st December, 1994".

Full details will be provided when they are known.

A near W.R. came in New York on 22 May when Jackie Joyner-Kersey, in her first outdoor L.J. competition of the season jumped 7.49m, just 3cm shy of the Record held by Galina Chistyakova (Russia)

WORLD JUNIOR RECORDS

With the World Junior Championship to take place in Lisbon later this year, find enclosed a list of the World Junior Records.

The list is up to date as of the 31st December, 1993.

My main sources have been *Track & Field News*, March 1994 and the *A.T.F.S. Athletics 1994*. They do differ on a few points, but for all of the major events they do agree.

It is believed that the only Junior Record to fall so far this year has been the Men's 100m, and that has yet to be ratified.
