### NATIONAL RECORDS

#### PNG

Late news of a record broken in Australia in 1993 has reached us. It was created by Ephredie Jubilee, a student at Kooralbyn International School in South East Queensland.

Ephredie threw the Javelin 39.96m breaking the old record of 39.84m set by ex-Kooralbyn student Lillyanne Beining in the Vanuatu Selection Trials/Mobil Grand Prix Event on 30th October in Port Moresby.

It appears as though Lillyanne Beining has broken her NR for the 100mH when she ran 14.55 in the Queensland U20 Championships. This broke the record of 14.68 that she set twice (on consecutive days) in Seoul in September, 1992. We are waiting for confirmation of the wind reading before confirming it as a new NJR and NR.

It is hoped that Tom Brandt in Queensland can confirm the above performances.

The two good performances from Auckland - Lillyanne Beining's 14.13 in the 100mH was unfortunately aided by an illegal wind of 3.5m/s and Daniel Kaputin missed equalling the NJR for the LJ as his 6.68m was aided by a wind of 3.6m/s.

In the NZ Championships in Hamilton the week after the Oceania Titles Lillyanne once again bettered her NR of 14.68 for the 100mH when she ran 14.61.

When all of the wind readings are known for the Brisbane and Hamilton performances, we will then be able to say what is the NR for the 100mH.

### MORE M.S.P.G. STATISTICS

Using the I.A.A.F. Scoring Tables (1992 Edition) the best performances at the Mini Games were ranked. The top performances are listed below.

It should be noted, though, that the 100m times would have been much faster had there not been such a strong headwind. As in Port Moresby in 1991, it was not uncommon to have negative winds of over 5.0 metres per second.

## VETERANS ATHLETICS

### \* WORLD MASTERS GAMES

This will be held in Brisbane in September. It covers many different sports and will attract thousands from all over the world.

### \* OCEANIA VETERANS CHAMPIONSHIPS

After the success of the Oceania Athletics Championships on Norfolk Island in 1992, this edition in Suva promises to be even bigger and better. It will be held from July 1 - 9.

## PERFORMANCES OF NOTE

Eamonn Coghlan (41 years old) of Ireland became the first veteran to run the mile in under 4 minutes when he clocked 3:58.15 at Harvard on February 20th. Eamonn ran this time indoors. The World Record for Veterans for an outside performance is held by Dave Moorcroft who ran 4:02.53 in 1993.

Olga Kuzenkova of Russia broke her own WR in the H.T. when she threw the hammer 66.84 at Sochi. Australian, Debbie Sosimenko threw the hammer 62.38 in Melbourne on Feb 24 to break her own Commonwealth Record.

It was recently revealed that Sun Caiyun broke the WR for the Women's Pole Vault in Guangzhou on March 21st last year. She jumped 4.11m

I will continue to give wide coverage to the "new events" for Women - the T.J., Steeplechase, P.V. and H.T. These events will eventually be seen in South Pacific competition and it is not too soon to introduce them to the Women of the South Pacific.

The Hammer Throw has been a regular fixture in competition in New Caledonia for some time and the leading thrower there is Pamela Ferland who so far this year has thrown 47.44m. Pamela holds the N.C. Senior Record with a throw of 53.80 in 1991 while still a Junior.

Mereoni Vibose from Fiji was throwing the Hammer back in Australia in the 1980's and at one stage creating N.S.W. Resident Records with throws of 33.50m in 1983 and 38.74 in 1984.

## NEW CALEDONIAN THROWING - 1993

The Monthly Magazine - *Trajectoire* - put out by the *Association des lanceurs du Pacifique*, has ranked the throwing performances by their athletes in the 1993 by allocating points according to the old I.A.A.F. Scoring Tables (the 1962 Belgrade Edition for the Men's events and 1971 Edition for the Women's events). On a separate sheet find a copy of these rankings.

With no Scoring Table for the Women's Hammer Throw, points for this event have been allocated using the performances for the Javelin.

Using the 1992 I.A.A.F. Scoring Tables, which take into account the changes in world standards in throwing events, and the fact that there is a new Men's Javelin, the order for both lists would be changed with J. Claude Terebo emerging as the top performer of 1993 with his J.T. mark of 70.96m and the Jeunes List would be headed by Gaétan Siakinuu-Schmidt with his javelin throw of 69.74 to win the gold medal in Vila in December.

The top five performers for 1993 in each throwing discipline will be included in the next bulletin.
