

## FINDING YOUR FFA NUMBER AND PASSWORD

1. Go to website [www.myfootballclub.com.au](http://www.myfootballclub.com.au) and select "Register Now"

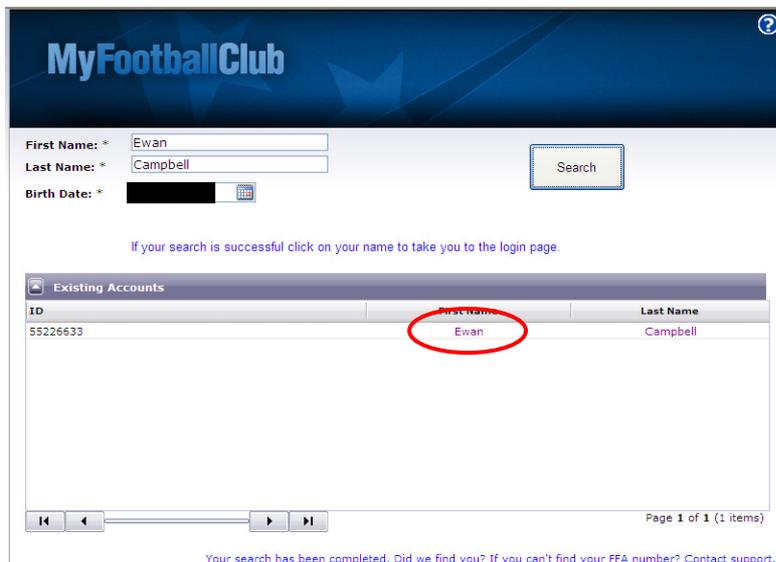


2. Select "FIND YOUR FFA NUMBER"



3. Enter the players First Name, Last Name and DOB, then press "Search"

4. If your search is successful, click on your name to take you to the registration login page.

6. You can now enter the email address that you think is already in the FFA system (ie the email address that you entered when registering last year) and click on "Proceed"

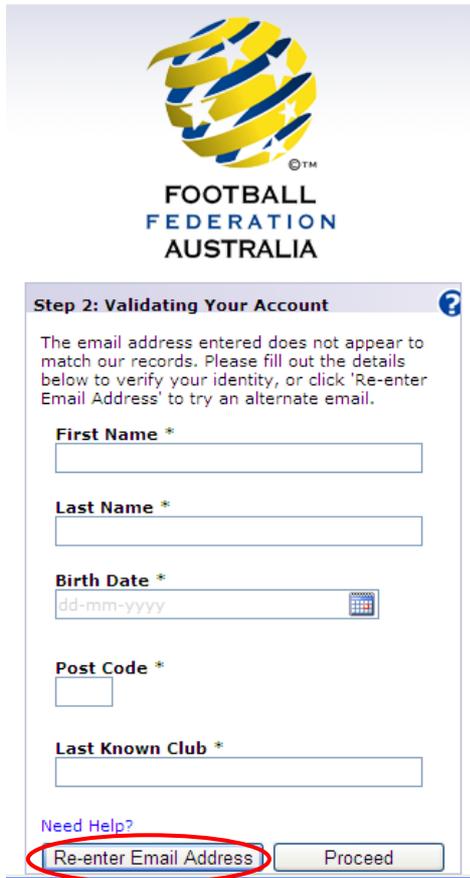
