

FINDING YOUR FFA NUMBER AND PASSWORD

1. Go to website www.myfootballclub.com.au and select "Register Now"



2. Select "FIND YOUR FFA NUMBER"



3. Enter the players First Name, Last Name and DOB, then press "Search"


