5. There will only be one (1) Minor Premier per age division.
6. It was decided that teams would be allocated the following "reward" ladder points leading into phase 2 of the competition fixtures commencing on Sunday July 21st.

2. For the purpose of the remainder of the competition, the 9 teams will split into two pools of either $5 / 4$ or $4 / 5$ dependant on ladder positions and points.

Pool A - First (TBA) teams- as per ladder at the completion of Round 9, 30 June 2013.
Pool B - Next (TBA) teams as per the ladder at the completion of Round 9, 30 June 2013.
3. The ladder for all teams will reset to zero (0) at the completion of Round 9, 30 June 2013.
4. For the purpose of identifying the minor Premiers, all points earned during the 2013 season will be held and carried.
5. There will only be one (1) Minor Premier per age division.
6. It was decided that teams would be allocated the following "reward" ladder points leading into phase 2 of the competition fixtures commencing 14th July for 4 team Pool.
