- Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player. Always conduct yourself in a manner that is expected of your Team Mates, Club or Family.
- Cooperate with your Coach and Team Mates, and respect the ability of your opponents. Without them there would be no game.

PARENTS AND SPECTATORS OF JUNIOR FOOTBALL CODE OF CONDUCT

- Encourage children to participate if they are interested. If a child is unwilling do not force them.
- Focus on the child's efforts and performance rather than the overall outcome of the event.
 This assists the child in setting realistic goals related to their ability by reducing the emphasis on winning.
- Teach your child that an honest effort is as important as a victory so that the result of each game is accepted without undue disappointment.
- Encourage your child to always play by the rules.
- Never ridicule or yell at your child for losing a competition. Avoid use of derogatory language towards any person
- Remember your child should be involved in football for their enjoyment not yours.
- Your child learns by example. Applaud good play by both your team members and members of the opposing team.
- If you disagree with an official or an umpire, raise
 the issue through the appropriate channels
 rather than questioning the official's honesty and
 judgement in public. Most officials give their time
 and effort for your child's enjoyment.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from junior sporting activities.
- Recognise the value and importance of volunteer coaches. They give of their time and resources to provide recreational activities for your child and deserve your support.
- Support your club officials in maintaining the highest standard of behaviour both on and off the field for the betterment of the league and your family. Offer assistance to your child's team and the club in general so that every opportunity is being provided for the very best supervision and support. Your involvement will give both yourself and your child far more satisfaction.

New Tobacco Bans

Victorian Government has amended the Tobacco Act 1987 (the Act) to ban smoking at certain outdoor public areas

The new bans will provide children and young people with a healthy, smoke-free environment in which to play. These laws commenced from 1 April 2014 to prohibit smoking:

 at or within 10 metres of outdoor children's playground equipment



 at or within 10 metres of outdoor sporting venues during organised sporting events
