
WABL Vision Statement

- 4. Well-developed oral and interpersonal skills, with the ability to communicate and work with people from a variety of contexts
- 5. Sound knowledge and understanding of the needs and issues of WABL basketball for all stakeholders
- 6. Availability and attendance at Kalamunda Eastern Suns and Basketball WA Coaches workshops
- 7. Commitment to the provision of quality coaching and service for WABL participants

Desired:

- 1. Previous experience as a WABL Coach
- 2. No direct family relationship between the WABL Coach and potential players in the WABL team
- 3. NCAS Level One Basketball Coaches accreditation
