BVABA - SENIOR BASKETBALL CARNIVAL RULES

Team officials are advised to read thoroughly the following RULES and make certain that their coaches/players are thoroughly conversant with the Rules. Additional copies of the rules can be obtained on request.

1. No player is allowed to play in more than one team or Grade.
2. A player must play in two games to be eligible for finals. (There will be at the least 4 Minor round games per team).
3. A player not seated on the bench must have their name deleted from the score sheet at half time. Should such a player arrive at half time their name will be reinstated on the score sheet by the umpire
4. No nomination of teams for the Carnival will be accepted without the appropriate entry fee being paid.
5. Cheques are to be made payable to "B.V.A.B.A. - Senior Carnival" and marked "NOT NEGOTIABLE", or by Postal Note.
6. Each team must provide a competent scorer or time keeper for each entire game in which that team plays. The penalty for not doing so shall be 5 points awarded to the opposing team.
7. A team official must complete a teamsheet and forward the sheet to Barossa Basketball by the date specified on the Nomination Form, or complete a teamsheet at least 30 minutes before the scheduled starting time of their 1st game, and record the players names on the official scoresheet for their 1st game.
8. Any team not present on the court at the scheduled starting time shall be penalised two points for each minute, or part thereof, that the team is late. Any team more than ten minutes late shall forfeit the match concerned.
9. Forfeits shall count as a 20 - 0 loss to the team forfeiting and a 20 - 0 win to the opposing team.
10. Premiership points shall be 2 win, 1 draw, 0 loss -1 forfeit -2 disqualified.
11. In the case of a tie for final position, total percentage will decide.
12. Bad language and unsporting conduct will not be tolerated during the Carnival and offending players, and/or officials, will be dealt with severely by the Tribunal. BVABA Codes of Conduct will apply to all players, coaches, spectators and officials.
13. Every player must wear the uniform nominated by their club (each violation awards 2 points to the opposition). If possible, also bring "alternate" uniforms.
14. No player will be permitted to enter the court if incorrectly dressed.
15. All teams provide their own warm up balls. The match ball will be chosen from the warm up balls
16. EACH TEAM MUST PLAY ALL GAMES AS PROGRAMMED.
17. Any protest or dispute must be referred in writing to the Carnival Manager or their substitute within one (1) hour of the completion of the match in question. All protests will be heard by the Carnival Committee.
18. Special or unusual situations arising during the Carnival will be considered by the Carnival Committee in an effort to reach an amicable solution.
19. The Umpire - in - Charge will be the Rule Interpreter, who will handle any problems or complaints regarding F.I.B.A. Rules and Carnival Rules.
20. Any breach of these rules will be dealt with by the Carnival Committee.
21. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to re-grade teams depending on the standard and number of entries.
22. Clubs/Teams will be held responsible for any damage at the playing venue(s).
23. Only 2 Division 1 (Metro District) players allowed per team in the interests of "even" competition.
24. Any team with an ABA player must nominate for A-Grade.
25. TIMING (MINOR ROUNDS):- 2 X 20 minute halves, maximum 1 minute break between halves. Only 1 timeout per team per half (none allowed in last 2 minutes of any half). The clock will not stop in minor round games.
26. FINALS:- The same as "Minor Round", except full championship rules will apply in the last two (2) minutes of the game in the last half.
27. FIRST AID: Each team will need to provide their own first aid requirements.
