TOURNAMENT DETAILS

- **Dates:** Saturday 20th – Sunday 21st February 2016
- **Venue/Location:** Sydney
- **Team Entry:** \$750
 - Minimum of 5 games over 2 days (dependant on team entries and final positions)
 - Includes pool entry for player and team officials.
- **Tournament Structure:** One Championship Division.

TEAM ENTRY

- Players can be of any age and must have played no less than two thirds (2/3) of scheduled games within their respective district in either the 2015 Winter or 2015/16 Summer competitions.
- Up to fifteen (15) players per team are allowed to participate during the Tournament with a maximum of thirteen (13) to pay per game. Teams cannot include members from other regions other than as provided via the draft administered by WPNSW

REGISTRATION

- Team entries to be submitted no later than COB Thursday 3rd December 2015.
- Team nominations due no later than COB Friday, 8th January 2016.
- ALL players are required to be registered on Fox Sports Pulse with nominated Club.
- Payment required via direct debit with team registration to secure position

PLAYERS DRAFT

- Player draft nominations (teams and individuals) due no later than COB Friday, 8th January 2016. Placement of draft players will be managed by the WPNSW Office.

TEAM DUTY

- Each team is required to provide the following people who must be available at the scheduled start times. Infringement penalties apply per incident if people are not available at the required time to attend to duties:
 - One (1) competent table official for your own game to act as time keeper or secretary. All nominated persons are required to read the WPA Table Officials Teaching Manual Link: http://issuu.com/waterpoloaus/docs/wp_aust_table_officials_manual_vers.
 - One (1) suitably qualified or competent referee for the next game after the team plays OR as appointed by the Referees Coordinator. Referees are to be appropriately attired including wearing a white shirt.
 - One (1) player to act as goal judges in the game after you play.
