2016 TRIALING PLAYERS INSTRUCTIONS

As part of our drive to make as many registration processes easy on Club Registrars for the 2016 season advise the following process for Trialling Players at affiliated clubs will apply for the 2016 season.

- For players who are Australian National's the following applies:
 - A. All players returning to the club they were registered for in the 2015 Outdoor Season are covered for insurance up to the first competition fixture. To participate in trials for that club, they don't need to be registered on MyFootballClub until required to by their competition administrator or prior to the first competition fixture;
 - B. Any player who comes to a club that was registered to another FFA affiliated club (even interstate) in the 2015 Outdoor Season is covered for insurance up to the first competition fixture. To participate in trials for a new club, they don't need to be registered on MyFootballClub until required to by their competition administrator or prior to the first competition fixture;
 - C. Any player who comes to a club that does not fall into point a) or b) is not covered for insurance from the 2015 season. To participate in trials for a club they need to complete and submit an online <u>Request to Trial</u> form. They don't need to be registered on MyFootballClub until required to by their competition administrator or prior to the first competition fixture;
