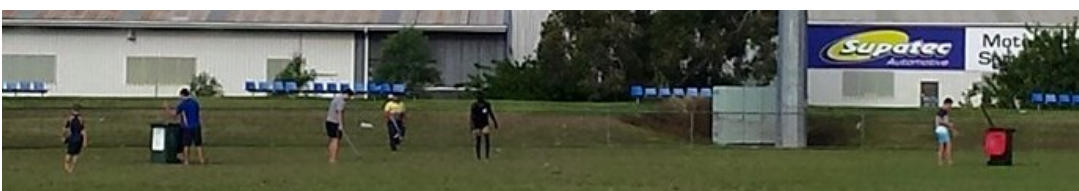
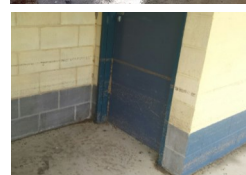
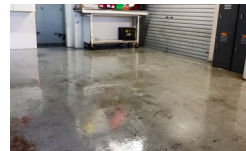
## CLUBHOUSE RENOVATIONS

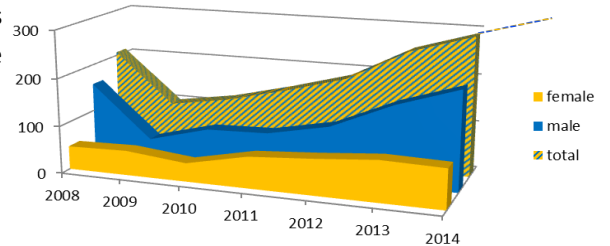
