Rules for AFL Masters National Carnival Revised Rules for 2016 Carnival

General Rules:

- Only 1 player from each team to contest any ruck or boundary throw-in. Penalty against 3rd. man up (unless play on is called by field umpire), football is to be thrown up at all times not bounced.
- If no boundary umpires in place, the field umpire brings the ball in 20-25m and throws it up.
- No player can raise a knee in any rucking contest or when attempting to mark the football, a free kick is paid whether contact is made or not, it's about the action of raising your knee.
- The player in front of the pack competing for the mark is to be given every protection, i.e. no player can use their knee or boot into a player's body or ride shoulders.
- No slinging, shirtfronts, front on contact, rough conduct, late contact, tackling that may cause injury, anything remotely high is high!
- After a point and all clear Goal Umpires must have finished waving their flags before play recommences (no quick kick in).
- No penalty for deliberate rushed behinds.
- No deliberate out of bounds penalty.
- No time on. The only exception is when a stretcher enters the ground or an ambulance is required on the ground, this shall be determined by match management. See below.

Time clocks will stop in the event of a stretcher or ambulance being called by Trainers, play will resume when injured person is off the ground, this will be determined by the National Board administration at the ground as to how it will be managed.

- Player stretchered off the ground may not play again in the carnival unless cleared to do so by the carnival doctor.
- In addition to an umpire, a controlling body (being in this case the AFL Masters Board) may authorise a person or persons to report any player or official who commits or engages in conduct which may constitute a Reportable Offence. Any person so authorised shall have the same powers and duties as imposed upon an umpire under this law 19.

Super Goal (12 points):

A Super Goal is when a player kicks a drop kick goal from a minimum 20 metres out (grounds shall be marked with an arc line 20 metres out from goal). The ball must be dropped kicked and go between the goal posts either on the full or bounced through without being touched. The ball must pass entirely over the goal line.

- Super Goals are signalled by the field umpire raising both arms straight above his head to signal to the goal umpire all clear.
- Goal Umpires are to then raise both their arms straight above their heads to signal, and then wave one white and one coloured flag (coloured flags shall be available at each oval).

For the avoidance of doubt:

1. From a mark, free kick or 50m penalty (see next paragraph), the setting of the mark must be no closer than the 20 meter arc line and the player must kick the football from outside the 20m arc line.

- 2. In relation to the above, the setting of the mark determines the point a Supergoal can be attempted, e.g. if the mark is set inside the 20m arc and the player goes back outside the arc to take his kick a Supergoal cannot be attempted.
- 3. Should a player play on or in general play, they must kick the football from outside the arc line.
- 4. Should a ground not be marked with a 20m arc the field umpire shall determine if a Supergoal has been scored.
- 5. Should there be any doubt on whether it's a Super Goal or not, the field umpire has the final say. However we encourage field umpires to consulate with goal and/or boundary umpires to determine any Super goals if there is doubt and it still can't be determined it's judged a normal
- 6 point goal.

Super Goal in relation to a 50m penalty being applied:

- 1. Should a 50m penalty be applied and it would take the player inside the 20m arc the player can elect to attempt a Super goal but the mark is to be set no closer than the 20m arc, should a player elect to not attempt a Super goal the mark can be advanced inside the arc, this may include but not limited to being set on the goal line, but a Super Goal (12 points) cannot be attempted.
- 2. Furthermore, should a 50m penalty be applied from within the 20m arc the player can elect to have the mark set back on the 20m arc and attempt a Super Goal (12 points).
- 3. On both these above occasions where a 50m penalty has been applied and the player elects to attempt a Super Goal the mark is set directly in line with the centre of each goal.

Rational: it is to the greater penalty against the offending side (this is then consistent with all other rules as referenced in the Laws of Australian Football).

Send-off coloured cards:

- **GREEN CARD** Automatic send off until end of current quarter plus one additional quarter.
- **YELLOW CARD** Automatic send-off for remainder of the match.
 - **RED CARD** Automatic send off for remainder of match plus reported.

Send Off Cards shall be issued to umpires at the ground.

Send off rule: Any player sent off by the umpire can be replaced during the penalty period. Players can be sent off but not limited to the following indiscretions.

VERBAL ABUSE - Green Card

Verbal abuse or dissension to any person on field (ie. Umpire, opposition player or team mate) or any self-abuse using abusive language, auditable language.

UNDULY ROUGH PLAY - Yellow Card

Unduly Rough Play (shirt front, charge, or any unnecessary tackle or challenge likely to cause injury)

FIGHTING - Red Card

Offences you would deem reportable offences, i.e. striking by fist, elbow or foot, head-butt, umpire assault, the higher end of the scale type offences.

 Second offence of Green Card (or yellow) in the same match will automatically attract a Red Card. Any player who receives a Red Card is automatically reported and referred to the Board for further action and they cannot take part in any other games that day. All send-off's must be recorded on match paperwork including their Name, Number, State, Colour of card and offence.

At the end of the 1981 footy season Morningside player lan Polglase and coach Ray Buckley travelled to Ray's home town Darwin where they saw a Victoria v NT Superules match. The "why can't we do this in QLD" seed was planted.

At the end of 1982, Superules founder John Hammer met with Ian to further discuss Superules in QLD and in July 1983, Courier Mail Sports columnist Peter Blucher publicised the inaugural Superules meeting to be held at Morningside football club on Sunday July 10. The meeting was attended by 14 people.

From this meeting, it was decided that players 35 years of age and older would meet every second Sunday to train and play a game amongst themselves. They met at various grounds including Morningside, Windsor Zillmere, Mayne and Coorparoo.

In 1984 after growing interest and participation, it was decided to form the first formal Queensland Superules Executive Committee along with four geographical teams rather than individual clubs to ensure the spirit of fun was maintained. Easts, Souths, Norths and Wests were formed (with the Brisbane River dividing north and south and Ipswich and Gympie roads dividing east and west) and games were played every second Sunday morning at various grounds. Both games were always played at the same ground and a barbecue, beer and raffles always followed.

In 1987 the North Coast joined the competition and in 1991 the Gold Coast became the sixth team to even up the competition. A fortnightly bulletin was published and made available at the following game and all players were keen to see if their on or off field exploits made it to print.

QLD participated in its first national carnival later that year in Darwin and its first game was against Tasmania. At the end of the carnival Rod Diprose and P Sauerbeurg were named as QLD's inaugural All Australians.

In 1987, QLD hosted its first national carnival at Coorparoo footy club. This was also the first year that an over 40s exhibition game was played and featured QLD. Two years later there would be a full over 40s carnival competition.

In 1992, the Gold Coast hosted the second QLD carnival at Labrador footy club. And this year saw QLD win its inaugural national championship, taking out the over 35s Division 2 and the over 40s. This carnival also saw the first over 45s game and QLD once again featured. And four years later there would be a full over 45s carnival competition.

It took QLD until 2001 to win its first over 45s championship, held at Southport, and in 2005 won its first over 50s carnival in Adelaide.

In 2015 QLD fielded its first ever over 60s team at the Tasmania carnival.

From its humble beginnings and through the dedication and hard work of many people over its 33 year history, QLD now has 38 clubs from Coolangatta to Cairns and west to Mt Isa. And in this 2016 home national carnival, will field 14 sides and 325 players. Not bad for a rugby league state!


