



AFL QUEENSLAND DEVELOPMENT STAFF/CLUB AGREEMENT 2017

We, the undersigned, have formalised a working agreement between our club and the AFL Queensland Game Development and Junior Football Departments for guidance throughout the 2016 season.

AFL Queensland Game Development will do the following action items in 2017 to support your club:-

1. Communicate and provide general assistance and advice where required around Grants & Funding, Volunteer Management, Facilities, Strategic Planning and Club Governance.
2. Resource, market and promote Club Auskick for the club well in advance of proposed start dates, and provide assistance with up skilling of volunteer Club Auskick Coordinator.
3. Work with club in achieving transition of participants from AFLQ programs to the club.
4. Provide the club with information on AFL School and AFL Auskick programs being delivered within the Hub Aligned School Document. Provide club with information on Regional Talent programs being conducted.
5. Deliver AFL Junior, Youth and Senior Coach Accreditation courses within the region.
6. Work with the club to develop a plan towards having female football teams at the club.
7. Run a league "transition forum" for all junior clubs to attend.
8. Provide Social media for your teams

AFL Queensland Junior Football Department will do the following action items in 2017 to support your club:-

1. Oversee all Junior and Youth football operations and ensure best practice competition management.
2. Support clubs to ensure there is strong and sustainable governance and environment structures are in place.
3. Assist club to implement new plans.
4. Ensure clubs know of all upcoming courses and meetings.
5. Ensure club is aware of all activity they can promote and recruit new players from.
6. Share ideas between clubs and to maintain open communication between club and league.

A working agreement between the Junior Australian Football Club and AFLQ Game Development Department has been reached with key objectives listed below for both Club and AFL Queensland to implement during 2016.

Key Objectives (Example Only)

1. Coordinate and run a Club Auskick Program.
2. Appoint Club Auskick Coordinator.
3. Appoint quality coaches in all age groups and aim for 100% of coaches accredited in Junior, Youth or Senior courses.
4. Appoint Coaching Coordinator.
5. Implement volunteer Recruitment and Retention program to sustain and maintain a quality club environment.
6. Develop a strong foundation of under 6's and 8's to develop a strong future base of players.
7. Work with AFLQ in the promotion of having female teams.
8. Work with AFLQ in the promotion of the club and transition of participants from NAB AFL Auskick, Sport Education and Interschool Sporting competitions.
