Administrators Report

2016 the Association faced its biggest challenge trying to manage an Association while facing being taken over by the SANFL. This was a particularly stressful year for the Executive and Clubs and volunteers and certainly took its toll on everyone while also trying to administer competitions, Clubs and Teams.

The Executive were committed in continuing to support the Clubs through the ongoing meeting process with the SANFL addressing Club concerns and issues with the new junior competition proposal. To everyone's credit we carried on through another successful season.

Once again the season commenced with the U6 Carnival at Para Hills Football Club this year with 250 new players to the league having their first taste of team footy and loving every minute. The Executive once again were all hands on deck manning the BBQ for all the hungry players and handing out footy's to all the kids.



This year the Association engaged with Good Sports to provide education and awareness to Clubs around responsible service of alcohol and good practice to support Club Committees with behavioural issues on game days.

U6 to U10 non premiership grades had 135 teams and the focus has always been on participation and development in these grades. Clubs in these age groups have had good success with retention and growth of junior football and its ongoing development in the North Eastern Suburbs.

There were 113 teams across U11 to U14's with good numbers across 3 divisions in each grade and the U15's /16's had 2 divisions. Clubs and coaches were able to provide competitive games played in the spirit of the game and allowing all teams aspiring to play finals.

It was another successful finals season with 8 Clubs taking home flags from 16 divisions. Payneham NU won 4 Premierships; Angle Vale took home 3 and TTG 2. The Finals series were hosted by the Clubs who did a fantastic job once again this year with everyone enjoying Grand Final Day. 2 successful Medal Counts were held at Athelstone and Broadview with Georgia Mckee from Elizabeth winning the first medal in a mixed competition by a female player.

Our annual AGM dinner held at Salisbury North Football Club was the culmination of the Season for Clubs to celebrate and valuable volunteers were recognised for their service to the Association in supporting junior football in a variety of roles. This is always the highlight of the season where we can all relax and celebrate the enormous amount of commitment and hard work that goes into managing clubs and junior football.
