9. What are the objectives of your project? For example, your proposed project must have as its main objective: Improve some aspect of the sporting infrastructure in the home country, general and specific to a particular sport. Please see ICECP brochure for a list of possible topics.
10. What are the reasons for your choice? Please explain your personal reasons for wishing to improve the selected area within your country's sporting infrastructure.
11. How will you evaluate the success of your project (e.g. number of participants, creation of curriculum, improvement in performance of athletes, development of athlete development pipeline, etc)?
12. Submit a copy of your National Federation support letter
13. Curriculum vitae (CV)
14. Copy of Passport

Priority will be given to a national coach who has been identified as a coach for the 2017 Pacific Mini Games, 2018 Commonwealth Games and 2020 Olympic Games.
