- BW Membership card operates as a light card.
- BW Membership card loaded with \$20.00 light credit.
- When membership is renewed, \$20.00 light credit is loaded onto existing card.
- 10% discount on all rackets and shoes purchased at the Pro Shop that are not already discounted.
- On payment of BW membership fee, the member will receive a voucher entitling them to one free restring (There is no member and non-member restring pricing as of 1st March 2017).
- Other discounts and promotions will be available to members only during the year.

BW Rules

- The Cardholder/Member must be present for the entire duration of the court hire.
- Playing on unlit courts is prohibited.
- Your card may be suspended in the case of improper use.
- Place all your unwanted used shuttles in the baskets provided at the end of your court booking.
- Please ensure that all rubbish is removed and placed in the rubbish bins provided.
- No animals are permitted in the hall.
- Last person out needs to ensure the alarm is set and the entrance door and any other exit doors are closed.
- Badminton Wellington is not responsible or liable for personal accidents, injuries sustained or for any loss, theft or damage to goods or participants.
- Badminton Wellington may hold you liable for damage that may rise from negligent use, or leaving the premises unsecured.

Etiquette

- Stay well clear of the courts while the shuttle is in play, when you are not playing. It is dangerous to be too close to the back of the court during a rally as the players will not know you are there and may hit you when going for the shuttle.
- Do not lean on the net, pull down the net, or shake hands over the top of the net. The bolts holding the posts up are under enough pressure already.
- If you hit the shuttle into the net, it is your responsibility to retrieve it and pass it over to the opponent. However, if you are the opponent and closer to the shuttle, it is friendly to get the shuttle yourself.
- It is disrespectful to hit a grounded shuttle to the opponent like a field hockey player, and it is not good for the shuttle.
- You should call your own faults, such as the shuttle hitting your body, the shuttle nicking your racket before the other person on your side hits it back, or both players on one side hitting the shuttle in one turn.
- You make the line calls for shuttles landing on your side of the net, and respect the calls your opponent makes for shuttles landing on their side of the net.
- If your shuttle lands on an adjoining court during play, wait for a gap in the game on that court before retrieving it. Do not interrupt a rally to get it back.

Terms and Conditions

- 1. All details provided are true and correct.
- 2. I am over 18 years of age. (If not, this document needs to be counter signed by parent/legal guardian who agrees to be subject to these terms and conditions.)
- 3. I understand that this card is not transferable and I will not let anyone use it while I am not present, nor will I book a court for anyone else in my absence.
- 4. Membership Card entitles the holder <u>ONLY</u> to Member Benefits outlined above i.e. shop discounts, member court hire rates etc.
- 5. PLEASE ENSURE YOU HAVE ENOUGH CREDIT ON YOUR CARD WHEN MAKING YOUR BOOKING.

I understand that should I have insufficient funds on my card I will not be able to book a court either online, by phone or email.

Staff can make court bookings over the phone or via email as long as the Members Card is in credit – STAFF CANNOT BOOK A COURT IF YOU HAVE INSUFFICIENT CREDIT ON YOUR CARD.

- 6. I understand that my BW membership entitles me to turn on <u>one court only</u>. This will be charged at the member rate(s). My card is <u>not</u> capable of turning on more than one court at the same time. Should I want to book a second court at the same time, this must be done via the Pro-Shop and will be charged at the non-member rate.
- 7. I will abide by the rules of Badminton Wellington a copy of which has been provided to me.
- 8. If my card is lost or stolen, I will inform Badminton Wellington immediately.
- 9. I understand that a \$30.00 fee will be charged for a replacement card.
- 10. I understand should my BW card show no activity (i.e. no court bookings or top ups made) for a period of 24 months, my card will be cancelled and any credit will be lost.
- 11. If I am the last person to exit the facility, I will ensure that the alarm is set and the entry door and all fire exits are closed.
- 12. I understand that money credited to this card is non-refundable.
- 13. I understand that my membership card is valid through to 28 February 2018.
- 14. Direct Pro-Shop Members: I understand that if a new membership is not purchased within 1 month of the membership coming due again in 2018, my card will still operate as a light card and my court hire rates will be charged at the non-member rates, and I will not be entitled to any BW Member benefits.
- 15. I understand that if any of the above conditions are breached my card may be deactivated and I will lose any unused credit.
- 16. I understand that, on rare occasions, Badminton Wellington may require a court that I have booked for other purposes. Where this occurs my booking may be cancelled or moved to another court. Badminton Wellington will make every effort to notify me in advance should this occur.
