### Junior Tryouts & Registration

As we move from the winter to the summer season you will be aware that age groups change leading into the next season. Players born in 2008 or later will be Under 10, players born in 2006 or 2007 will be Under 12, and players born 2004 or 2005 will be Under 14 and so on.

In order to select teams for the upcoming summer season we will be holding tryout on Monday 5th and Tuesday 6th September at the YMCA in Newtown. Keep your eye posted for details of dates and times for each age group.

On the try out night families will be able to pay their YMCA basketball club memberships which have stayed at the same level again this year. Family memberships are \$175 per year, with an early bird discount of \$20. Single memberships are \$110 with a \$10 discount for paying prior to the deadline.

### Selection of Teams for Next Season

We get lots of requests at the start of each season requesting certain players are put together in the same team as their friends. Whilst we understand this, and most certainly want the kids to have fun playing basketball, there are a number of reasons why this may be not possible. Team selection is based on a number of factors and whilst we would love everybody to be able to play in teams with their friends, teams need to be selected on what is best for both the team and the individuals' development. This also means that in most cases it will not be possible to just keep groups of players together in the same teams as they move through the age groups. I am sure you understand the need for such an approach, and it doesn't take long for kids to make lots of new friends in the teams in which they are playing.

### Are you Playing Next Season?

If you know of players that are going to return to basketball after a season off playing football or netball please let the coaches or coordinators know of their intentions. As mentioned already, we will only be able to accommodate new players or returning players if we have sufficient coaches for each team.
