

New Team-sheet – Completing on the Day – Referee and Match Day Supervisor

Match Day Supervisor

- Please print the name of the Referee and AR's.
- If the AR's are volunteers then please write CLUB.
- Please print the name(s) of the Ground Officials.

Referee

- If not done, please print your name as the Referee and the name(s) of the AR's - found at the top of the team sheet. If the person was a volunteer please write CLUB.
- Put down the total number of goal against the individual. Please note the team sheet is in alphabetical order not shirt number.
Own Goals use code (OG)
- Record any disciplinary action using the correct offence code. (Over Page)
- Complete the total score (under coach ID numbers)
- Complete the total number of cautions and send offs
- Sign the team sheet.

Any player which you have sent off requires you to write a report. This can be completed at home or after you have completed your duties for the day.

AR's (not Club) are also required to submit reports if the send -off is R1, R2 or R6 or there was a further incident afterwards (e.g. a player dismissed for R7 then used foul and/or abusive language on leaving the field)

This needs to be at the FSC office by Tuesday of each week.

FSC CAUTION CODES

Code	Description
Y1	The player is guilty of unsporting conduct.
Y2	The player shows dissent by action or word.
Y3	The player persistently infringes the Laws of the Game.
Y4	The player delays the restart of play.
Y5	The player fails to respect the required distance when play is restarted with a corner kick, free kick or throw in.
Y6	The player re-enters the field of play without the Referee's permission.
Y7	The player deliberately leaves the field of play without the Referee's permission.

FSC SEND OFF CODES

Offence Number	Description
R1	Serious Foul Play
R2	Violent Conduct
R3	Spitting at a player or any other person
R4	Denying the opposing team a goal or an obvious goal scoring opportunity by deliberately handling the ball
R5	Denying an obvious goal scoring opportunity to an opponent moving towards the player's goal by an offence punishable by a free kick or a penalty kick
R6	Use of Offensive, Insulting or Abusive Language or Gestures
R7	Two yellow cards in a match
