RULES & SCORING

1. Each team shall supply a goal and central umpires are supplied by the league.
2. There are no boundary umpires. If the ball goes out of bounds by foot, whether on the full or not, a free kick will be awarded to the opposing team. A player CANNOT score directly from this free kick. If the ball goes out of bounds but NOT off a player's foot, a ball up shall occur 5 metres inside the boundary at the point where the ball went out. Normal "out of bounds on the full" and "deliberately out of bounds" rules still apply.
3. Team Managers for all teams will be required to report to the recorder upon arrival to confirm attendance, collect all relevant paper work and to submit team sheet.
4. Teams named first shall kick to the northern or eastern end.
5. At the completion of each game the team managers shall escort the umpires from the oval.
6. Team managers shall supply the Recorder with results of matches, etc.
7. The point's allocation is as follows:
 - a) 1 points for the winner of each half;
 - b) Half a point if teams have equal scores in a half
 - c) 2 point for the overall winner of the game; and
 - d) In the case of a tie in points, the team with the better percentage becomes the premier.
8. Match Balls: Under 14 division use size 5 match balls. Match balls will be supplied by the league.
9. Order off Rule: As per VCFL rules.
10. Blood Rule: It is preferable that umpires don't stop play and we ask clubs to replace players affected by the blood rule as soon as possible without interrupting the game.
11. Teams are to play 18 per side and no more than 6 interchange players.
12. Each team is allowed 2 water carriers. They are to deliver water after a goal has been scored or when the ball is at the other end of the ground, they are not to coach or deliver messages from the coach.
13. Runners are to be correctly attired wearing a high visible jacket and must deliver messages to the player from the coach as quickly as possible. They should not be on the ground for long periods of time and must not interfere with any players or officials.
14. Trophies and medallions for the winner of each division will be presented at the league Presentation Night the following Friday night.
15. Entry is \$5 per adult.
16. Hot and cold food and beverages are available at the canteens throughout the day.
17. Junior football is an smoke and alcohol-free zone.

JUNIOR FOOTBALL FUTURE DIRECTIONS PROJECT

On 9 June the AFL Goulburn Murray Commission launched its Junior Football Future Directions Project, one of its major projects for 2017.

The Project has a focus 'to examine the structure and format of junior football in the Goulburn Murray region and design and recommend a model for the future.'

Junior football in the Goulburn Murray from U18 and below encompasses over 4600 players representing 215 teams competing in eight different Leagues. This does not include almost 1800 Auskick participants spread across 48 centres. This diversity, both in governance and geographically, presents a number of challenges when it comes to ensuring we have the best model to recruit and retain junior footballers. It is this model and its working components that will be evaluated in this project.



In a major undertaking, 27 community football representatives have been assembled into four Project Teams to discuss concepts, debate ideas and develop recommendations to be considered by the Steering Committee. Project Team members have been nominated by their League and thus represent all corners and junior football configurations in the region.

The launch of the Project coincided with the release of an online survey which has been distributed to all clubs in the region. The response from the survey was excellent with 69% of clubs submitting their views on the 22 questions asked.

On 28 June the four Project Teams came together for the first time and the survey results were presented before each Team broke away to consider their key focus areas. Some of these key areas of discussion included the governance structure of the three stand alone junior Leagues, the age group structure in each League, the transition process from Auskick to club and then from junior to senior football, the rules, permits and interchange agreement in place between Leagues and the application of the AFL Junior Match Policy.

The feedback after the meeting has been very positive and the Steering Committee will meet in the next week to consider the outcomes from the first meetings before the next round of Project Team meetings will be held.

Once the Project Teams have completed their processes and developed their recommendations the Steering Committee will consider and compile a draft report which will be presented in open forums later in the year. A feedback window will then open for written submissions to be received before the final recommendations will be ratified by the Commission for public release.

The release of this review has stimulated much discussion and debate, which is great. It must be kept in mind, however, that any changes to the current structure will need to consider the broader impact. For example, a scenario drawing attention in the public domain at the moment is the GVL playing U16s on Saturday prior to the U18s. Let's play this out.

There are currently 20 teams playing in two U16 Sunday competitions in the region, 14 of them represent 10 GVL clubs. Benalla (two teams) and Mansfield compete in the Wangaratta DJFL U16s. If the GVL started U16s on Saturday morning and each club moved their Sunday U16s into the Saturday morning time slot, the Shepparton DJFL U16s would be left with four teams and the Seymour DJFNL would have six teams. For these competitions to be unsustainable would actually result in reducing the overall participation opportunities at that age group. This is without even considering travel implications, match timings are other considerations.

Whilst this does not eliminate this as an option it is important that we consider the domino effect of change and this is just one example of the many scenarios that will be considered and discussed throughout the Project.

Importantly, the review has a process in place to consult all stakeholders and engage clubs in the decision making. Decisions made will be evidence based and the project is being delivered as per AFL Victoria guidelines to ensure it is engaging, thorough and equitable.

We are committed to the process and the Steering Committee welcome the input of football supporters and community members as we continue to evolve the structures surrounding junior football.
