- 1.1 The current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) of World Sailing (WS) and the Prescriptions of Australian Sailing. (AS).
- 1.2 The Special Regulations of AS Parts 1&2.
- 1.3 The Boating (Safety Equipment) Regulations of NSW.
- 1.4 The Relevant Class Rules 2017/18 for classes entered
- 1.6 The Australian Measurement System (AMS)
- 1.5 The GSC sailing hand book and Fleet's sailing instructions
- 1.6 This Notice of Race, as amended by the Sailing Instructions
- 1.7 All GSC Events are subject to NSW Maritime Regulations and the GSC Aquatic License Issued by NSW Maritime.
- 1.8 For the purpose of these rules the Race Committee will consist of the Commodore, Sailing Manager, Class fleet delegates, or their nominated deputy.

## **2 ADVERTISING**

- 2.1 For the purpose of advertising, the classification of this event shall be in accordance with WS Regulation 20,
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising material chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

## **3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRIES**

### **3.1 Centerboard Classes**

**Junior Class:** Entry is open to boats of the following classes: Junior Sabot, Senior Sabot, Optimist F11s and miscellaneous centerboard Classes.

**Senior Classes:** Entry is open to boats of the following classes: Laser 4.7, Laser Radial, Laser Standard, A Class Cats and a miscellaneous centerboard Classes. Each boat shall comply with part 2 of the AS safety regs and hold a Class measurement certificate when appropriate

### **3.2 Keel Boat Classes**

Sports Boats and Yachts. Each keel boat shall hold and lodge with the Organising Authority a current valid Australian Sailing Special Regulations Compliance Certificate, minimum of Category 7 and an AMS measurement certificate if applicable.

- 3.3.1 International Etchells Class Association rules and regulations shall apply except as altered by the Sailing Instructions.

- 3.3.2 At the commencement of each season each Etchells shall present copies of: -

- i) Current measurement certificate & sail card.
- ii) Current Category 7 Safety Certificate. The crew shall ensure continuing compliance throughout the season.
- iii) NSW RMS registration

iv) Racing insurance including \$10M public liability cover.

3.3.3 In any championship race, a change of helmsperson shall be permitted, provided the new helmsperson is a regular member of the crew. (The regular crew should be determined prior to the commencement of the season, with alterations restricted to say a week prior to the start of each series.)

3.3.4 In any non-championship race, a change of helmsperson shall be permitted provided the new helmsperson is a sailing member of Gosford Sailing Club.

3.3.5 A crew may elect to sail either 3 or 4 up. This crew configuration must then be maintained until the end of the series. A change in the crew configuration will be permitted during the season from series to series.

3.4 For boats with crew to be awarded points in Club Championship series, all members of the crew must be Financial Sailing Members of the Club.

3.5 For boats with crew to be awarded points in pointscore events, all members of the crew must be Financial Sailing Members of the Club, however a non-member may sail for a maximum of three (3) races.

3.6 A non-member shall be deemed to be a visitor up to and including three (3) races in any sailing season. A visitor shall be counted as a starter, with all rights accorded to the vessel while racing, but will not be counted in the finishing positions. A visitor who subsequently joins Gosford Sailing Club or who has lodged an application for membership which is being processed, shall be considered to be a Financial Member for up to the three (3) races competed in as a visitor

3.7 Exemption to these rules may, in the event of extenuating circumstances, be granted by the Sailing Committee.

3.8 Saturday fleet eligible boats may enter by completing the online registration and, together with the required fee, to the Organising Authority prior to 1700hrs on Wednesday 25th October 2017.

3.8.1 Yacht fleet eligible boats may enter by completing the online registration and, together with the required fee, to the Organising Authority prior to 1700hrs on Wednesday of the first race in the series.

3.9 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Organising Authority, which if accepted may attract a late entry fee. Financial Sailing Members of the Gosford Sailing Club and visitors as defined in the sailing instructions shall be eligible to compete in races conducted by the Club, except that only Financial Sailing Members of the Gosford Sailing Club may be eligible for Club Championship points.

3.10 Gosford Sailing Club reserves the right to refuse an entry

#### **4 FEES**

4.1 GSC Members race entry fees are as described in the fleet race entry form online

4.2 Visitors \$25.00 for seniors and \$10.00 for juniors per race.

## **5 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS**

- 5.1 This Notice of race applies to all events organised and conducted by the GSC as listed in the GSC program of Races 2017/18 unless otherwise noted
- 5.2 Dates of racing: Racing will be conducted on the dates published in the GSC year book, and on the GSC Web site
- 5.3 It is the intention of the Race Committee to conduct the races as per the program, but the Race Committee may alter the Schedule of Races as required.

## **6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 6.1 Sailing Instructions will be available after registration at the Gosford Sailing Club and are contained in the GSC year book and may be available online on the GSC website.

## **7 RACING AREA**

- 7.1 The races will be conducted on Brisbane Waters off Gosford Sailing Club.
- 7.2 Offshore Races will be conducted of the East Coast Tasman Sea between Terrigal in the North and Sydney South Head in the South.

## **8 COURSES**

- 8.1 Courses will be as described in the Sailing Instructions.

## **9 PENALTY SYSTEMS**

- 9.1. The Two Turns Penalty, rule 44.2 shall apply or as described in the SIs

## **10 SCORING**

- 10.1 The scoring system shall be the Low Point System, RRS Appendix A. and series scored as described in the Sailing Instructions
- 10.2 If a boat does not race because her crew is required to perform race committee duties, or because she is representing GSC at an official event in any class, she may be awarded average points equal in accordance with the sailing instructions for that day's GSC Championship or Pointscore race (amends Appendix A).

## **11 PRIZES**

- 11.1 Prizes will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> Place on Handicap in each Class or division
- 11.2 Annual Championship Prizes will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2nd and 3<sup>rd</sup> in each Class or division
- 11.3 Annual Point Score Prizes will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2nd and 3<sup>rd</sup> in each Class or division
- 11.4 Twilight Race Prizes will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> in each Division after each race

11.5 Other prizes may be awarded at the Race Committees discretion.

## **12 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

12.1 While racing, and except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make nor receive radio communications that are not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## **13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY & RISK WARNING**

13.1 It is the competitor's decision to enter the Event or to start and continue in any race. Competitors shall accept that their participation in the Event is at their exclusive risk in every respect. By way of entry in the Event competitors must indemnify the Organising Authority their officers, members, staff and agents in respect to all claims and demands of whatever nature which may be made upon them in connection with or howsoever arising from their participation or intended participation in the Event.

13.2 This RISK WARNING is issued jointly by Gosford Sailing Club and NSW Maritime, pursuant to the Civil Liability Act 2002 to all persons wishing to participate in the sailing activities conducted by Gosford Sailing Club.

Participants are warned that, regardless of the precautions, which might be taken by reasonable and experienced persons, sailing can be a dangerous pursuit and participants are exposed to significant risk of property damage, physical harm and possibly death.

As an indication, these risks may include, but are not limited to:

- The extremes of weather and sea conditions.
- The potential that control of vessels may be lost, resulting in collision with objects and other vessels.
- The sudden movement of the vessel at any time and the possibility that participants may fall or be thrown overboard, resulting in drowning.
- The possibility that participants may be injured by equipment on the vessel.
- The absence of immediate medical care and the likelihood that significant delays may occur before medical care is available.
- Exposure to the elements for extended periods.

Gosford Sailing Club and NSW Maritime also warn participants that regardless of their best intentions, they may be unable to render assistance to participants who are in distress. Participants are warned to consider the above risks and all other risks before deciding to participate in any sailing event with Gosford Sailing Club.

Participants are also advised that although Gosford Sailing Club is covered by third party liability insurance, this cover DOES NOT extend to participants. Any participant who considers they have a need for insurance must make their own private arrangements with an insurer. Membership of a sailing club affiliated with Yachting NSW entitles you to personal accident insurance cover.

## **14 INSURANCE**

- 14.1 Participants are advised that GSC's third party liability insurance cover does not extend to participants. Participants must make their own private arrangements with an insurer.
- 14.2 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000.
- 14.3 Attention is drawn to Australian Sailing's insurance program at [Home](#) / Australian Sailing Insurance Programs, through which a proportion of insurance premiums paid by members is rebated to GSC.
