



10A Rules

In accordance with the By-laws of the Junior Competition the following shall apply for ALL 10A Grades:

- No Finals Series will be played.
- No scoreboards shall be used.
- No uniform penalty.
- Raised rings used with free throws taken from the bottom of the free throw circle.
- No restriction on the number of dribbles a player may take.
- Full court defence is permitted.
- Coaches are permitted to walk from the end line up to their side of the score bench.
- Teams are allowed to use Players from any 10s team, including opposing Domestic Clubs, to avoid a forfeit.
- If there is an insufficient number of Players to play a game, the Coach may train their Team.
- Successful three point shots shall count as two (2) points.
- 3 second rule to apply in full
- Travel rule to apply in full
- Cross court rule to apply in full
- Line violations will be call in full



10B Rules

In accordance with the By-laws of the Junior Competition the following shall apply for ALL the 10B Grades:

- No Finals Series will be played.
- No scoreboards shall be used.
- No uniform penalty.
- Raised rings used with free throws taken from the bottom of the free throw circle.
- A maximum of five (5) bounces is permitted except on fast break situation (i.e. No defence in front of dribbler). Violation to apply in full.
- The defence shall retreat to half court after a basket is scored and in all out of bounds situations in the offensive backcourt. Full court defence is then permitted, once the ball is inbounded.
- On all front court inbound situations, no player may begin inside the keyway. Once the ball is handed to the inbounder, movement into the keyway is permitted.
- Coaches are permitted to walk from the end line up to their side of the score bench.
- Teams are allowed to use Players from any 10s team, including opposing Domestic Clubs, to avoid a forfeit.
- If there is an insufficient number of Players to play a game, the Coach may train their Team.
- Successful three point shots shall count as two (2) points.
- 3 second rule to apply in full
- Travel rule to apply in full
- Cross court rule to apply in full
- Line violations will be call in full



10C Rules

In accordance with the By-laws of the Junior Competition the following shall apply for ALL the 10C Grades:

- No Finals Series will be played.
- No scoreboards shall be used.
- No uniform penalty.
- Mini-Boards shall be used with free-throws taken from the bottom of the free throw circle.
- A maximum of five (5) bounces is permitted except on fast break situation (i.e. No defence in front of dribbler). Violation to apply in full.
- The defence shall retreat to half-court after a basket is scored and in all out of bounds situations in the offensive backcourt.
- On all front court inbound situations, no player may begin inside the keyway. Once the ball is handed to the inbounder, movement into the keyway is permitted.
- Coaches are permitted to walk from the end line up to their side of the score bench.
- Teams are allowed to use Players from any 10s or 8s team, including opposing Domestic Clubs, to avoid a forfeit.
- If there is an insufficient number of Players to play a game, the Coach may train their Team.
- Successful three point shots shall count as two (2) points.

Following are additional interpretations and applications for the U10C grade.

<u>Rule</u>	<u>After first regrade</u>
3 Seconds	<i>3 warnings and then called.</i>
5 dribble rule	<i>Called – referee to explain. Ball given to opposing team.</i>
Cross Court	<i>Called – only obvious situations – e.g. dribble or pass clearly into back half – referee to explain Ball given to opposing team.</i>
Travel on start and stop of dribble	<i>Called – referee to explain. Ball given to opposing team.</i>
Line violations on pass-in	<i>Referee to talk to the player. Ball given to opposition.</i>



8s Rules

In accordance with the By-laws of the Junior Competition the following shall apply for all the 8s Grades:

- No Finals Series will be played.
- No scoreboards shall be used.
- No uniform penalty.
- Mini-Boards shall be used.
- Referees shall determine where free throws shall be taken from.
- A three (3) bounce limit is permitted with a maximum of five (5) bounces.
- The defence shall retreat to half-court after a basket is scored and in all out of bounds situations in the offensive backcourt.
- A coach is permitted on court briefly during a stoppage in play to position or reassure players, but must leave the court as soon as play is ready to resume.
- Teams are allowed to use Players from any 8s team, including opposing Domestic Clubs, to avoid a forfeit.
- If there is an insufficient number of Players to play a game, the Coach may train their Team.
- Successful three point shots shall count as two (2) points.

Following are additional interpretations and applications for the U8 grade.

<u>Rule</u>	<u>All season</u>
3 Seconds	<i>Not Called</i>
3 dribble rule	<i>Called – referee to explain Ball given to opposing team.</i>
Cross Court	<i>Not Called but communicated.</i>
Travel on start and stop of dribble	<i>Called if no reasonable attempt to dribble before stepping or stopping, passing or shooting within a couple of steps (i.e. running with ball) – referee to talk to player Ball given to opposing team.</i>
Line violations on pass-in	<i>Referee to talk to the player. Ball given to opposition.</i>
