#### WHO IS REQUIRED TO RUN???

- ★ Officials wishing to officiate all U18s Games and U16s Boys Round Games
- ★ Officials wishing to progress to Finals in U14s and above Divisions.
- ★ Officials wishing to referee CPL in all age groups & State Championships/State Cup and wishing to be eligible for JDP and State Grading's

Officials who are injured/medically unfit can attend the Action Day and run the Fitness Test when medically cleared (A doctor certificate and medical clearance must be provided).

I acknowledge that the FIBA fitness test is a requirement to participate in the Waratah League or any BNSW Tournament for the 2018 season. Officials will be required to meet the minimum FIBA Fitness level to be eligible for 16s Boys and 18s Boys and Girls Round Games, finals for U14s and above divisions, all age groups of CPL, JDP and to attend State Championships and State Grading's.

I know of no medical condition that will put me at risk from participating in this test or refereeing.

I absolve Basketball NSW from any liability in my undertaking the fitness test or refereeing.

I further authorise Basketball NSW or its staff the in the event of an accident or illness that occurs while participating in the fitness test or refereeing to obtain all necessary medical assistance.
