Definitions:

The Oratia Skills Academy

This involves opening the academy to all playing levels with a lower price structure making it more accessible to a wider group of players 7th through 14th.

Team Training Academy

This is designed for teams to train together in a more tactically focussed way to enable them to function more effectively within their team shape during competitive games. Teams will enrol together and work on specific and relevant technical and tactical elements in a game specific framework.

• The Oratia Team Performance Academy will involve teams enrolling at a set rate for the group and being coached in specific team tactics and skills

Teams from 9th-17th Grade will be invited to apply. We encourage our first and metro teams to enrol as it provides the extra contact time they need within their age groups in order to develop.

Goalkeeper Academy

Run by club and goalkeeper coach George Smith, these will be held at the same time and venue and will be integrated into the programme where appropriate and necessary.
