Incorporating the S80 Wednesday Series

1. RULES

- 1.1 The Organising Authority (OA) is South of Perth Yacht Club (Inc.) (SoPYC).
- 1.2 Races will be governed by the rules as defined in:
 - a) The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
 - b) The Prescriptions of Australian Sailing (AS) including the Special Regulations.
 - c) The rules of the S80 Yacht Association of Western Australia (Inc.)
 - d) These SSI's and the SoPYC NoR and Keelboat SI's.
- 1.3 Racing Rules will be changed as follows:
 - a) RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty for all keelboat races.

6. RESULTS AND PENNANTS

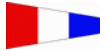

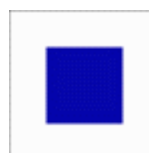
