NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the Australian Sailing (AS) Special Regulations Part 2 for Off the Beach Boats.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **2.1** The regatta is open to all boats complying with the International OK Dinghy Class Rules and possessing a valid measurement certificate.
- 2.2 Competitors must be financial members of a state International OK Dinghy Class Association and of a club affiliated with Australian Sailing.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter via the TryBooking Link
- 2.4 Entries will be accepted until 12.00 noon 9/3/18

3. FEE

The required fee is \$80- per boat up to and including 4/3/18. For entries lodged after 4/3/18 the fee will be \$100-.

The regatta will be conducted by the Rye Yacht Club Inc, 2120 Point Nepean Road, Rye Foreshore on the waters of Port Phillip Bay.

8. COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be described in the Sailing Instructions

9 SCORING

- 9.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.2 If four or less races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 9.4 If five or more races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

Prizes will awarded by the Organising Authority.
