## **CURRENT LANDSCAPE**

- **AFL SE REVIEW:** Aim was to create a 3 division competition with all senior clubs
- **MPNFL:** Operate under a league constitution. Modified to block SEFNL. Move has been denied
- **2019:** 8 team competition will no longer exist
- New Home: Need to find new competitions in 2019
- Could be any number joining
- A. Find there own home
- B. Move as a collective

#### **Possible Destinations: Us, EFL or Southern**

- Best model is all coming, rather than a couple, as this provides the best outcomes for our clubs
- If not us, the majority will head to the EFL



## **KEY REVIEW FINDINGS**


- Need to find the right structure for

- Look at other competitions/clubs to bring to the competiton



## INTEGRATION

- Minimal changes for our clubs operationally
- Clear Parameters for joining different divisions
- Time to prepare
- Combination of ladder position and your club structure
- Administration stays the same
- Combining creates very competitive divisions
- Division 2 promotion on application/invitation
- SEFNL clubs unlikely to face Northern clubs in foreseeable future
- Open to 18's or 19's
- No affect on Yarra Ranges Juniors



## FOOTBALL

- Interleague opponent in 2018
- Competitive Balance can be found quickly
- Greater long term viability of clubs, as this allows clubs to find their level
- Creates long term stability for our region
- Very similar clubs and standard
- Long term capacity to grow the competition
- Outstanding playing surfaces and facilities
- Raises the standard of our premier division
- Provides clubs greater opportunity to compete in finals and grand finals



### NETBALL

- SEFNL is a football/netball competition
- Saturday Competition
- All venues have Netball courts (multiple courts)
- 4 Open Grades in each division
- Junior Netball on Saturdays
- Closest competition structure to ours
- Interleague and Association Championships
- Coach and club development focus in Netball
- Football and Netball Committees



## **OPERATIONAL**

**YARRA RANGES** 

- PRICE FREEZE 2019
- Valley Vision: \$200 per game
- Umpire costs to decrease

#### **SALARY CAP (Proposal):**

- Premier \$130-\$150k
- Division 1 \$100-\$120k
- Division 2 \$60-\$80k

#### **POINTS:**

Currently 39

## MISCONCEPTIONS

- **Standard:** They are very similar. We can compete straight away
- Growth Corridor: Points and Salary Cap, plus long term plans make this manageable
- Travel: 1 hour or less
- North: Will not impact our clubs
- 18s: A workable Solution can be found



### IMPLEMENTATION

- **Timeline:** 2019 introduction.
- **Review:** We are currently in a review. A formal recommendation under AFL Vic rule 4.7 can be presented for feedback
- **Timeframe:** We are able to provide clubs with sufficient time to be prepared for all changes.
- AFL YR: Ratification is via Commission.
- **Consultation:** Clubs to be consulted on delivery of competitions
- Meeting your club: We are available to meet clubs individually to discuss concerns and individual needs
- Future: Regional Plan 3<sup>rd</sup> Division with new clubs and North East

- Provides genuine, competitive competition for both football and Netball.
- Provides greater long term stability for clubs and region.
- Consultation- Variety of methods. Ability for you to shape of what this looks like into the future.
- Clubs will have ability to provide feedback via the review or meeting with staff.
