Victorian Junior & Youth Championships

Q. Can I purchase lunch during the coaching program and regatta?

A. SSCBC will be providing lunch at both events. To purchase food you can book online or purchase the item on the day.

Q. Can I drop my boat off early at SSCBC before the coaching clinic?

A. Yes, with drop off time below

6th April 9.00am – 6pm

7th April 9am – 5pm (Opportunity to sail at SSCBC Club Racing starting at 1.30)

Q. When can I register for the regatta?

A. If you have enrolled in the coaching program you can register at the registration desk at the same time for the Victorian Junior and Youth Championships. Otherwise registration desk will be opened on Saturday the 9th of April. Please refer to the NOR.

Q. How does the registration process work at the regatta?

A. Once you have arrived at the regatta make your way to the registration office. You will be required to look over your information and ensure your details are correct and have not changed. A parent/guardian (competitors 17 and under) must sign the declaration form. Any changes to competitor details can be made at that time. Once the racing is underway competitors will be required to fill in a change of competitor details form, available at registration desk.

Q. Coach/Support/Spectator Boats

A. All coach / support / spectator visiting RHIBS / boats must register prior to arrival. See online registration

Q. Is their storage for my boat trailer?

A. Trailer storage is available off site. We would encourage as many people to bring their own trailers home.

Q. Where is the nearest boat ramp?

A. You can launch and retrieve off the public ram any time prior to the event but you will need to take your trailer away. The public ramp is located west of the Ferry terminal.

Q. Can my boat stay in the water during the regatta?

A. Yes RIB's can stay in the water, overnight. Please ensure you have registered your boat online, refer to the YV website and confirmed your register "At owner's risk, SSCBC nor Yachting Victoria will be responsible for private RIBS".

Q. Where do I park my car?

A. Limited Parking is available at the Club and more is available along Nepean Highway and other side streets opposite the club.

Q. Where can I purchase spares for my boat.

Travelling to the club from the city Sport Philip Marine is on route in Mornington and locally there is the wooden boat shop is located 5 minutes from the club.
