Strategic Plan Update

- A number of sponsorship proposals have been submitted with potential new sponsors coming on board
- Some key activities being held in Wollongong to assist with the profile of the sport including the Tim Cahill Academy, Tottenham Hotspurs clinic and the Brazil vs Young Socceroos
