NATIONAL CODE OF CONDUCT

GENERAL PRINCIPLES

Participants in the game of Rugby League include:

All Players, Coaches, Sports Trainers (including League Safe Officers), Match Officials, Club Officials, Volunteers, Parents/Carers and Spectators.

Participants are encouraged and expected to:

- » Show positive acts of sportsmanship, discouraging all instances of foul or illegal play, or acts of violence, both on and off the field.
- » Demonstrate the greatest levels of respect, protecting the rights, dignity and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability / disability, sexual orientation, cultural background or religion.
- » Lead by positive example, and condemn the use of recreational and performance enhancing drugs and doping practices; their use endangers the health of players and is contrary to the concept of fair play.
- » Celebrate the “good news” stories, and understand that cyber-bullying, which includes negative or demeaning comments, status posts, personal messages or emails, is deemed as a serious form of harassment.
- » Accept that the integrity of the sport is of paramount importance, therefore, no coach, player, Club official or match official is allowed to participate, or be directly or indirectly involved in any way, in gambling in relation to the matches/competitions in which they are involved or directly linked.

2018 JUNIOR EXTRA TIME RULES/PROCEDURES

Extra Time Chairman's Trophy and Finals Series Matches

If at the end of the prescribed periods of normal play the score is level, the following maximum extra time shall be played, **until the first team scores** with no break between periods and no time off for injury:

For Under 12s, Five (5) minutes each way – Golden Try. (no Penalty Goals or Field Goals are allowed in Mod Football).

For age groups Under 13 to 18s: Five (5) minutes each way – Golden Point. So, any score (Try, Penalty Goal or Field Goal) in extra time, ceases play immediately with the scoring team declared the winner.

Extra Time procedure: The match will recommence with the Referee calling both captains together for a coin toss. The team winning the toss will be given the option of choosing which end of the field to defend, or alternatively elect to kick-off to commence play. If the team winning the toss elects to kick-off, the choice of ends reverts to the team losing the toss.

If in a Chairman's Trophy match the score remains level after the completion of extra time, dual trophies will be awarded.

If in a Semi Final or Preliminary Final, scores are level at the completion of extra time (5 minutes each way) the winner will be determined in the following manner:

- Most Tries Scored, then (if equal)
- First Try Scored, then (if no try scored)
- First Score, then (if no score) [NB does not apply to under 12s]
- First Penalty Received.

If in a Grand Final, scores remain level at the completion of extra time both teams will be declared joint premiers. This applies to all grades.

NOTE: In all games, other than Grand Finals it is imperative that the team which receives the first penalty of the match is noted (in the unlikely case of a nil all draw).

Note: If the Chairman's Trophy match is also a premiership fixture match and the score is drawn at the end of normal time both teams receive 2 premiership points each. Extra time is to determine the winner of the Trophy only.
