McKinnon Reserve is a popular sporting ground for local cricket and football clubs, and school sporting events.

### Dog leash information

The northern end of the park being the playground and main oval (closest to McKinnon Road) is on-leash. The southern end of the park (oval two) is off-leash.

- Glen Elra has designated areas (marked with green off-leash signs) in some parks that are off-leash areas.
- Dogs must be on-leash at all times outside of your home unless within an off-leash area.
- Dogs must also be under effective voice control at all times and kept on a leash that does not exceed 1.5 metres in length when within 20 metres of barbecues and picnic areas, children's playgrounds, sporting events, sportsground preparation and organised public meetings.

# SMJFL VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR AWARDS

## GENERAL VOLUNTEER

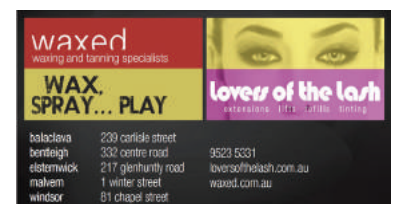

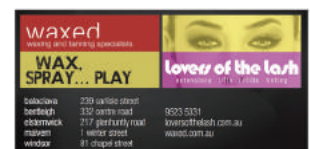
