Sections	Amendment	Purpose	Source
Points Deductions – Promoted Club	A Promoted Club will receive a deduction of 20 points from their Points Total. This points deduction only applies for the Promoted Club's first season following promotion into, or being granted a licence to participate in, the NPL.	Serves to avoid confusion of the interpretation of a 'Promoted Club'. The deduction will apply to both clubs promoted into the NPL and entities granted licence to participate in, the NPL.	FFA
General Definitions and Explanatory Notes – Promoted Club	A Promoted Club means: (a) a club promoted into the NPL from a lower tier competition, including a lower division of the NPL or, (b) is an entity granted a licence to participate in the NPL for the first time.	Aligned with the definition of 'Promoted Club'.	FFA
General Definitions and Explanatory Notes – Homegrown Player	 Homegrown Player (dot point 4 and 5). For the avoidance of doubt, a Player is eligible to receive a points deduction as a Homegrown Player where that Player was registered to the NPL Club's Age Eligible Teams, prior to that NPL Club being granted an NPL licence. Example: Prior to Club A being granted a licence to participate in the NPL, John Smith is registered to the age-eligible teams of Club A between 2010 and 2013 in the state league competition. On that basis, a total of four (4) points will be deducted from his points value for the current season. 	Provides clarity on the application of 'Homegrown Player' deductions to NPL clubs for players who were registered in the Age Eligible Teams of the respective club prior to that club having an NPL Licence.	FFA
