## 24 SECOND SHOT CLOCK: TIPS FOR THE OPERATOR

The 24 second shot clock will be used for CHAMPIONSHIP Division of Under 14, 16 & 18.

Under 16 & Under 18 will use the 14 second reset rulings. Under 14 will not use the 14 second reset rules.

In the Under 14 Championship Division, the 24 second shot clock will start once the ball crosses the centre line (half way).

Stop (pause) and reset to 24 seconds when:

- A shot hits the ring and the defensive team gains possession.
- When an official blows the whistle for a foul, violation or jump ball resulting in change of possession.
- When a shot for a field goal enters the basket.
- Foul in the back court.

Stop (pause) and reset to 14 seconds when (Under 16/18 Only):

• The ball hits the ring and the offensive team gains possession.

On a Foul in the front court resulting in the same team's possession:

- If the clock is above 14 seconds, then you hold on that number.
- If the clock is below 14 seconds it will reset to 14 seconds. Stop (pause) and hold (wait) the 24 second clock when:
- The same team is awarded the throw-in after the ball goes out of bounds
- When the jump ball is called and the same team has possession, following a double foul or after a game stoppage due to the team in control.
