



## **Representative Lead Coach 2020**

### **Year 9 - Role Description**

<b>POSITION:</b>	Representative Coach
<b>TERM:</b>	Current Season (with the right to renew if agreed to by both parties)
<b>START DATE:</b>	<b>December 2019</b>
<b>END DATE:</b>	<b>August 2020</b>

#### **PRIMARY PURPOSE:**

With the assistance of NWC appointed selectors and coach select a Year 9 representative team and lead a programme that develops and extends the best players for this age group.

#### **KEY PERFORMANCE AREAS:**

##### **1. Self-management and self-development**

- Continually reflect on and analyse own performance
- Create and maintain personal development plan
- Retains focus and composure while under pressure

##### **2. Develop a vision and planning**

- Create a common, shared, documented vision
- Document and submit a season plan to NWC
- Plan and implement a programme that creates a performance culture that fosters a will to win

##### **3. Managing the programme**

- Support the Head Selector in leading the Year 9 trial process with NWC support
- Ensure all players have fair playing time at tournaments
- Provide regular feedback to players with supporting data to enhance performance
- Reporting will be completed and submitted after each tournament (refer to template)

##### **4. Hands On Coaching**

- Manage performance in training by delivering planned and structured sessions that maximises available time
- Maintain player focus throughout training session
- Debrief training sessions to identify improvements
- Manage performance during tournaments



**KEY PERSONAL SPECIFICATIONS:**

The Lead coach will:

- Be available for all season commitments listed in schedule A
- Have a minimum of CCA or CCA1 accreditation or be engaged in ongoing learning by actively working towards CCA2 performance coach completion
- Have proven experience in lead coaching or assistant coaching at Yr 8, Yr 9, U16, or secondary school level
- Have proven experience in enhancing skill development and decision making in a competitive environment
- Have a sense of working in a wider coaching community with similar goals
- Nurture a love of competing and being the best they can be
- Perform within ethical expectations
- **Document and submit a season plan prior to start of campaign**

NB: A police check is mandatory for all applicants

**KEY OUTCOMES:**

- All players will have a fair and inclusive trial (refer to NWC selection policy)
- Up to 12 of NWC’s best Year 9 players will be selected
- The team achieves a top six placing in B division at the 2020 U16 North Island Champs
- Players will receive regular feedback to enhance their performance and that of the team through diaries provided by NWC
- Players will have fair court time at tournaments with at least two quarters per day
- Individual players are recognised in tournament teams (if there is a tournament team)
