NORTH EAST BORDER JUNIOR UMPIRE DEVELOPMENT COACH

Role Objective	<p>To develop, implement and review the coaching requirements of junior umpires in the North East Border region through the training at Albury/Wangaratta.</p> <p>Provide support and direction to junior field, boundary and goal umpires on their performance and provide opportunity for them to progress to higher grades based on their performance.</p> <p>Be actively involved in the recruitment and retention of umpires and actively promote umpiring in a positive way.</p>

Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Attend umpire training sessions on a weekly basis ➤ Plan and conduct coaching and training sessions specifically for junior umpires to assist and support them in their commencement as an umpire ➤ Appoint umpires to junior competition matches throughout the year ➤ Provide recommendations to the Umpire Manager for junior umpires to be appointed to senior matches ➤ Observe junior umpires on a regular basis and provide feedback. All reports to be sent to Umpire Manager for record keeping ➤ Appoint and support Umpire Mentors for junior umpires as required ➤ Provide mid and end of season feedback to junior umpires on their progress ➤ Participate in programs for the recruitment and retention of umpires by attending promotional or other events where required ➤ Assist with implementation and presentation of Basic Umpires Courses or other Introduction to Umpiring seminars ➤ Coordinate the use of AFL Development Programs for new umpires to the panel ➤ Participate in the AFL Umpire Coach Professional Development Program ➤ Attend coaches meetings when required ➤ Any other task as required by the Umpire Manager

Selection Criteria	<p><u>Mandatory</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ A positive and enthusiastic attitude towards the game of Australian Football, umpiring, coaching and personal development ➤ Ability to plan and implement a coaching and training plan for umpires ➤ Good interpersonal and communication skills ➤ Experience in umpiring, football and/or coaching ➤ Good knowledge of the Laws of Australian Football and other umpire requirements ➤ Able to commit to the requirements of the AFL Umpire Professional Development Program ➤ Working with Children Check or ability to obtain <p><u>Desirable</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Development or Advanced AFL Umpire Coach Accreditation or similar
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
