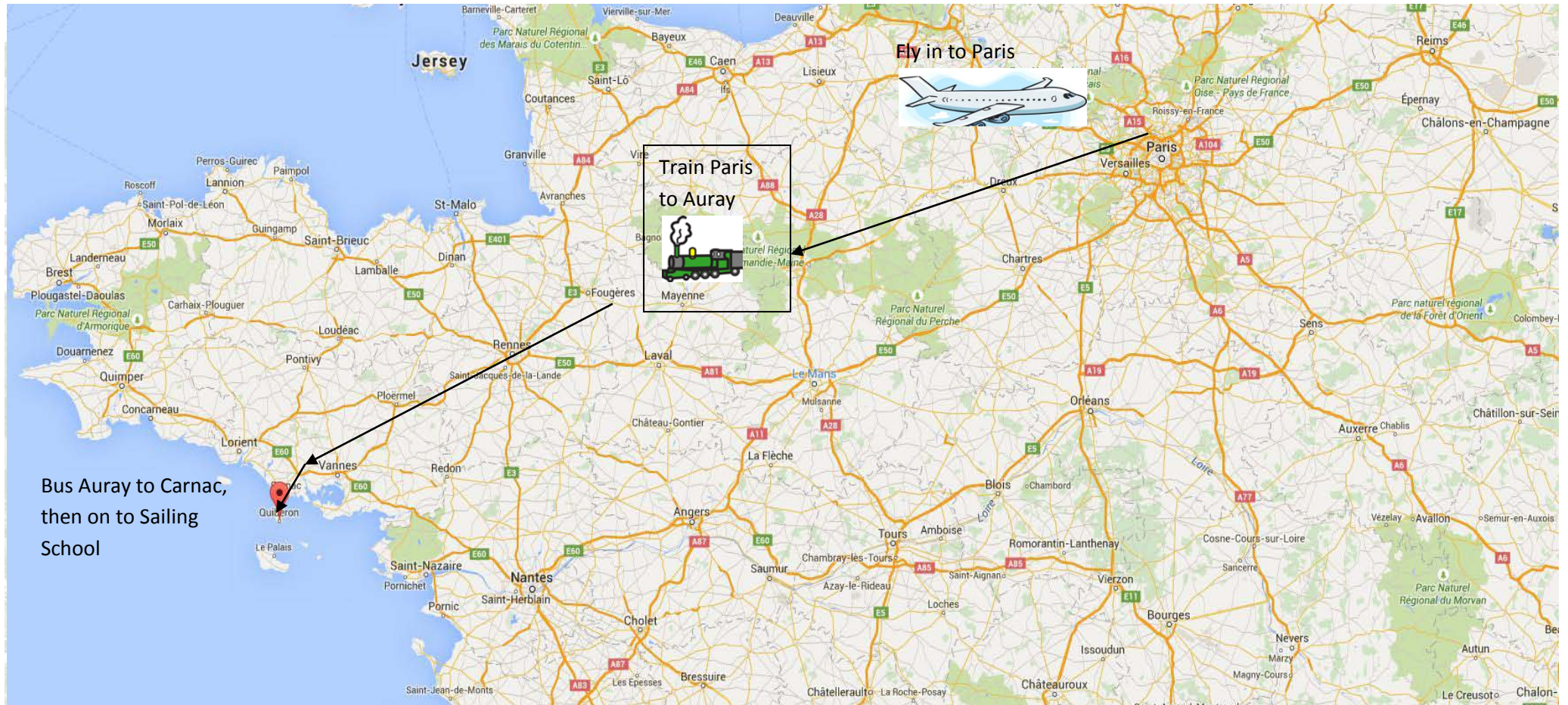

Estimate of Costs

Airfares – Aus – Paris return	A\$2,100 - \$2,500 per person
Train – Paris to Auray	A\$120 one way
Shipping/Entry fees, Tean Uniform etc (estimate)	\$2,500
Accommodation (low to high)	\$300 - \$1000

All of the above are estimates based on early booking. There are significant increases in train travel if you book late.

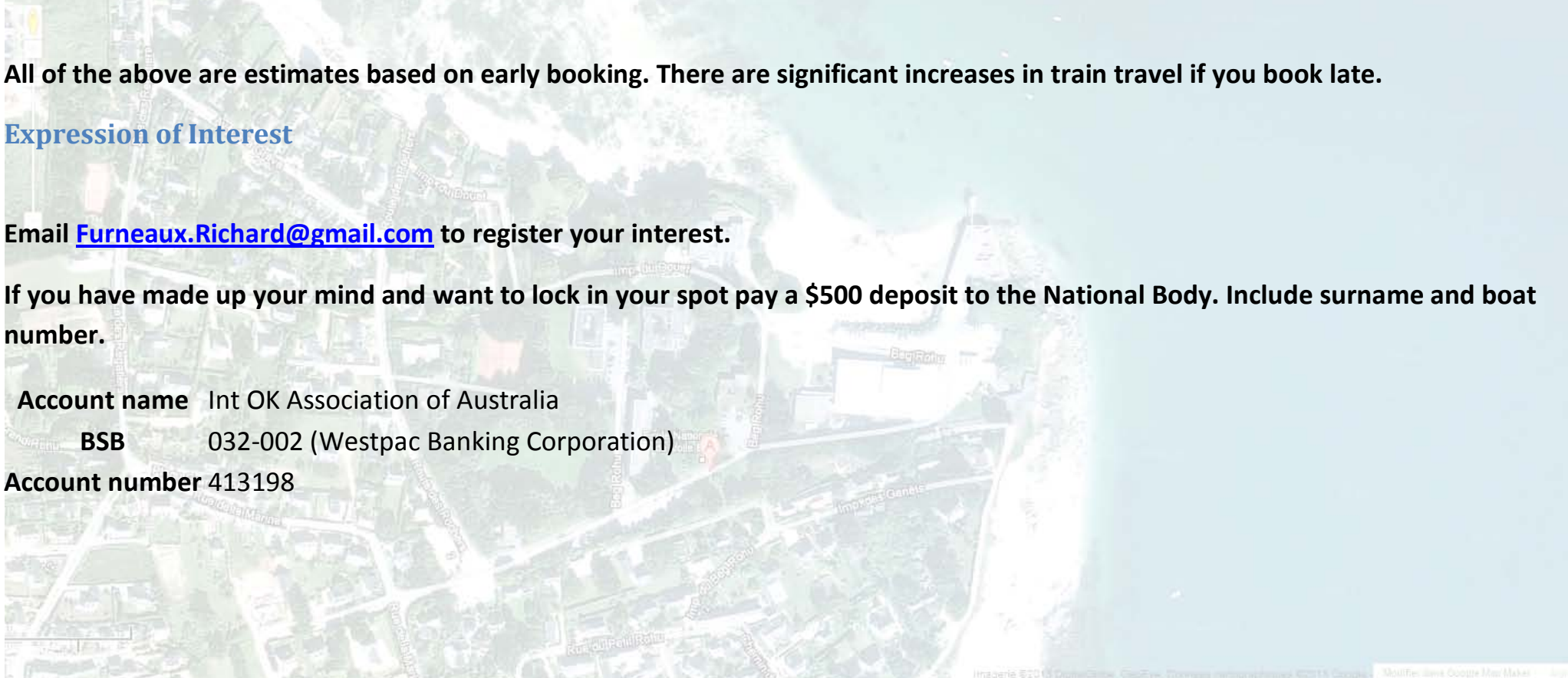
