### **SCHEDULE 3: BOUNDARIES**

The boundaries affecting each Club are defined as follows:

*Helensburgh*

Everything North of an East/West line drawn through the intersection of the crossing of Lawrence Hargrave Drive and School Pde, Clifton.

*Coledale*

From Helensburgh Southern boundary along Pacific Ocean to Mountain Rd, Austinmer to railway crossing and then straight line to intersection of Foothills Rd and Phillips St.

*Thirroul*

From Coledale Southern boundary, along Pacific Ocean to Woodland Creek, to Princes Highway and up Bulli Pass Rd.

*Bulli*

From Thirroul Southern boundary, along Pacific Ocean to Farrel Rd, to Princes Highway to Hospital Rd, and along Alanson Ave.

*Woonona*

From Bulli Southern boundary, along Pacific Ocean to Bellambi Creek which flows through Hollymount Park, and crosses Princes Highway.

*Russell Vale*

From Woonona Southern boundary to Bellambi Rd, East to Railway crossing, along railway line, south to East/West line through Albert St.

*Bellambi*

From Russell Vale Southern boundary, along railway south to Corrimal Railway Station along Murray Rd to Pacific Ocean.

*Corrimal*

From Russell Vale and Bellambi boundaries in the North to Towradgi Ck. Princes Highway North to Tarrawanna Road into Meadow Street, North to Foothills Rd. Cottage Grove into Justine Ave.

*Tarrawanna*

From Corrimal Southern boundary, South along Princes Highway to Douglas Rd. Meadow St along Wright St. to an East/West line drawn through Duncan St.

*Fernhill*

From Corrimal and Tarrawanna Southern boundary, along Princes Highway South to an East/West line from the intersection of Expressway and Princes Highway to Pacific Ocean.

*Balgownie*

From Tarrawanna boundary in the North and Fernhill boundary on East to an East/West line drawn through Mount Ousley Rd.

*Wollongong Olympic*

From Balgownie and Fernhill boundary in the North along Pacific Ocean to Crown St to Mount Keira Rd.

*Coniston*

From Wollongong Olympic boundary in the North along Princes Highway to F6 Freeway to Masters Rd, along Springhill Rd North to Pacific Ocean.



## **Schedules**

### *Figtree*

From Wollongong Olympic boundary in the North and Coniston boundary in the East along F6 Freeway to Mt. Kembla Railway Line.

### *Unanderra*

From Mt. Kembla Railway Line boundary in the North along F6 Freeway south to a East/West line drawn through Canterbury Rd to the Moss Vale railway line.

### *Berkeley*

From Unanderra Southern boundary and Eastern boundary along Berkeley Rd to an East/West line drawn through Flagstaff Rd (Lake Heights), South along Lake Heights Rd to Lake Illawarra, to Mullet Creek and Barretts Ck.

### *Lake Heights*

From Coniston boundary in the North, Unanderra and Berkeley boundaries in the West along foreshores of Lake Illawarra to Northcliff Drive and King St intersection, along King St, North to Five Islands Rd to Old Port Rd, Foreshore Rd, to Pacific Ocean.

### *Port Kembla*

From Lake Heights boundary in the North and West along foreshores of Lake Illawarra to an East /West line drawn just North of the South Pacific Caravan Park.

### *Warilla*

From Port Kembla boundary in the North, along the Pacific Ocean to George St, along Lake Entrance Rd to Landy drive, along Morgan Ave to Cuthbert Drive and Landy Drive and Gathercole Ave. The Western boundary is Lake Illawarra foreshore.

### *Lakeside Lions*

From Mullet Creek as the Northern boundary, South along Princes Highway to Byamee St, Brooks creek to Fowlers Road along Lakelands Dr South to Cornwell Rd intersection thence in direct line to Tallawarra Power Station.

### *Dapto*

From the Lakeside Lions and Berkeley boundaries in the North to Macquarie Rivulet and Marshall Mount Ck in the South.

### *Albion Park*

From the Dapto boundary on the North along the foreshores of Lake Illawarra to Horsley Creek. Along Horsley Creek to the main Railway line to Minnamurra River and upstream Minnamurra River.

### *Oak Flats*

From the Albion Park boundary along the foreshores of Lake Illawarra along the boundary of Warilla to Lake Entrance Rd. South on lake Entrance Rd to a North /South line drawn through the intersection of Tongara Rd and Dunsters Lane, along Dunsters Lane to the Main Highway.

### *Shellharbour*

From the Warilla boundary in the North and Oak Flats and Albion Park boundaries in the West along the Minnamurra River in the South to the Pacific Ocean

### *Kiama*

South of the Minnamurra River.

**Schedule 5: Definitions and Interpretations**

**A Definitions**

In these by-laws and regulations of the Junior Council unless the contrary intention appears:

**Accredited** means a person who has completed a course of relevant training recognised by the Association, FNSW, FFA.

**Appointed Councillor** means a Councillor appointed under by – law 10

**Club** means:

- (a) incorporated member club recognised by FSC and having the following characteristics:
  - (i) it organises teams to participate in competitions sanctioned by FSC and/ or FNSW;
  - (ii) all member clubs are entitled to “A” class membership as per FSC constitution
  - (iii) club members (or their parent or guardian) may vote in an election for any club officeholders;

OR

- (b) Any legal entity deemed to be a Club by FSC Junior Council.

**Club Member** means any club or organisation whether incorporated or unincorporated which is admitted into membership in accordance with FSC constitution and by – laws.

**Committee** means a committee established under by – law 12

**Councillor** means all or some of the councillors of the Junior Council.

**Even year** means the year ending in 0, 2, 4, 6, 8

**FFA** means Football Federation Australian Limited ACN 106 478 068

**FIFA** means Federation Internationale de Football Association.

**FNSW** means Football New South Wales Limited CAN 003 215 923

**Financial Club Member** means a club member who at the commencement of a general meeting, SGM or AGM of the Junior Council, has no outstanding invoices which are over 30 days.

**Financial Statements** means a statement of financial performance, a statement of financial position, a statement of cash flows and notes to each of these statements.

**Football** means “Association Football” as recognised by FIFA from time to time. To avoid doubt, at the date of incorporation of the Company, Football includes the games of soccer, soccer football, indoor or 5 a side (Futsal) soccer and beach soccer.

**Football Code of Conduct** means the code of conduct so named published by FFA and notified to members of FFA, as amended from time to time.



## Schedules

**General Meeting** means a general meeting of the Junior Council not being a special, annual or management meeting.

**Grievance** has the meaning given to that term in the Grievance Procedure;

**Grievance Procedure** means the procedure that applies exclusively to facilitate the expeditious and fair resolution of disputes and grievances that arise between the Members as promulgated by the Junior Council from time to time.

**ID Card means** identification card

**Ineligible Player** means a player who participates in a match and does not meet the regulations of the Junior Council in relation to borrowing.

**Laws of the Game** means the rules of Football referred to in the Statutes and Regulations.

**Life Member** means a person admitted to life membership under by-law 6 and those persons listed in Schedule 2 to these by – laws and the regulations.

**Match Day Supervisor** means the person, appointed by the member club, who is empowered to ensure regulations, rules, policies and safety are adhered where a match of football is being conducted.

**MPIO** means Member Protection Information Officer

**NRR means** the National Registration Regulations of FFA

**Odd Year** means the year ending in 1, 3, 5, 7, 9

**Official Position** means a person who holds a position, whether elected or appointed, as:

- (a) president, vice-president, secretary, treasurer, director, committee member of a club, association or other entity conducting, participating in or administering Football or any Football competition in Illawarra or zone 8 as defined by FNSW.
- (b) Coach and Manger appointed by member clubs or FSC representative coaches and manager.

**Registered Participant** means a person registered by the Association as per FFA Rules and Regulations:

**Special general meeting** means a general meeting of the Junior Council other than the annual general meeting or general meeting.

**SSG** means Small sided games

**State** means New South Wales excluding any part of New South Wales which is recognised by FFA as being under the exclusive jurisdiction of another member of FFA.

**Statutes and Regulations** means the Statutes and Regulations of FIFA, ASC and FFA in force from time to time.

**Team Official** means the person(s) who are the coach, manager of a team on the day of the match.

**Un-financial Club member** means a member club who at the commencement of a General Meeting, SGM or AGM of the Junior Council who has outstanding invoices which are over 30 days.



## B Interpretation

- (a) In these By-laws and regulations of the Junior Council:
- (i) **(presence of a Member)** a reference to a Member present at a general meeting means the Member present in person.
  - (ii) **(annual general meeting)** a reference to an annual general meeting in a calendar year,
  - (iii) **(document)** a reference to a document or instrument includes any amendments made to it from time to time and, unless the contrary intention appears, includes a replacement.
- (b) In these by – laws and regulations of the Junior Council unless the contrary intention appears:
- (i) **(gender)** words importing any gender include all other genders;
  - (ii) **(person)** the word “person” means a natural person;
  - (iii) **(successors)** a reference to an organisation includes a reference to its successors;
  - (iv) **(singular includes plural)** the singular includes the plural and vice versa;
  - (v) **(instruments)** a reference to a law includes regulations and instruments made under it;
  - (vi) **(amendments to legislation)** a reference to a law or a provision of a law includes amendments, re-enactments or replacements of that law or the provision, whether by a State or the Commonwealth or otherwise;
  - (vii) **(signed)** where, by a provision of this Constitution, a document including a notice is required to be signed, that requirement may be satisfied in relation to an electronic communication of the document in any manner permitted by law or by any State or Commonwealth law relating to electronic transmissions or in any other manner approved by the Directors; and
  - (viii) **(writing)** “writing” and “written” includes printing, typing and other modes of reproducing words in a visible form including, without limitation, any representation of words in a physical document or in an electronic communication or form or otherwise.
- (c) **Regulation 12.1 (i): main field** – is the field where SSG games for an age group are held, usually matches run at the same time and divide a competition field into smaller fields to conduct SSG.
- (d) **Regulation 15.2: out of field of play area** – this refers to the playing field where the match is being played, the technical area and inside the fence or marked boundary surrounding the field. If there is no marked boundary then the person sent off must remain twenty meters away from the field of play and is not permitted behind the goals.

## C Headings

Headings are inserted for convenience and do not affect the interpretation of this Constitution.

## D “Include” etc

In these by-laws and regulations of the Junior Council, the words “include”, “includes”, “including” and “for example” are not to be interpreted as words of limitation.
