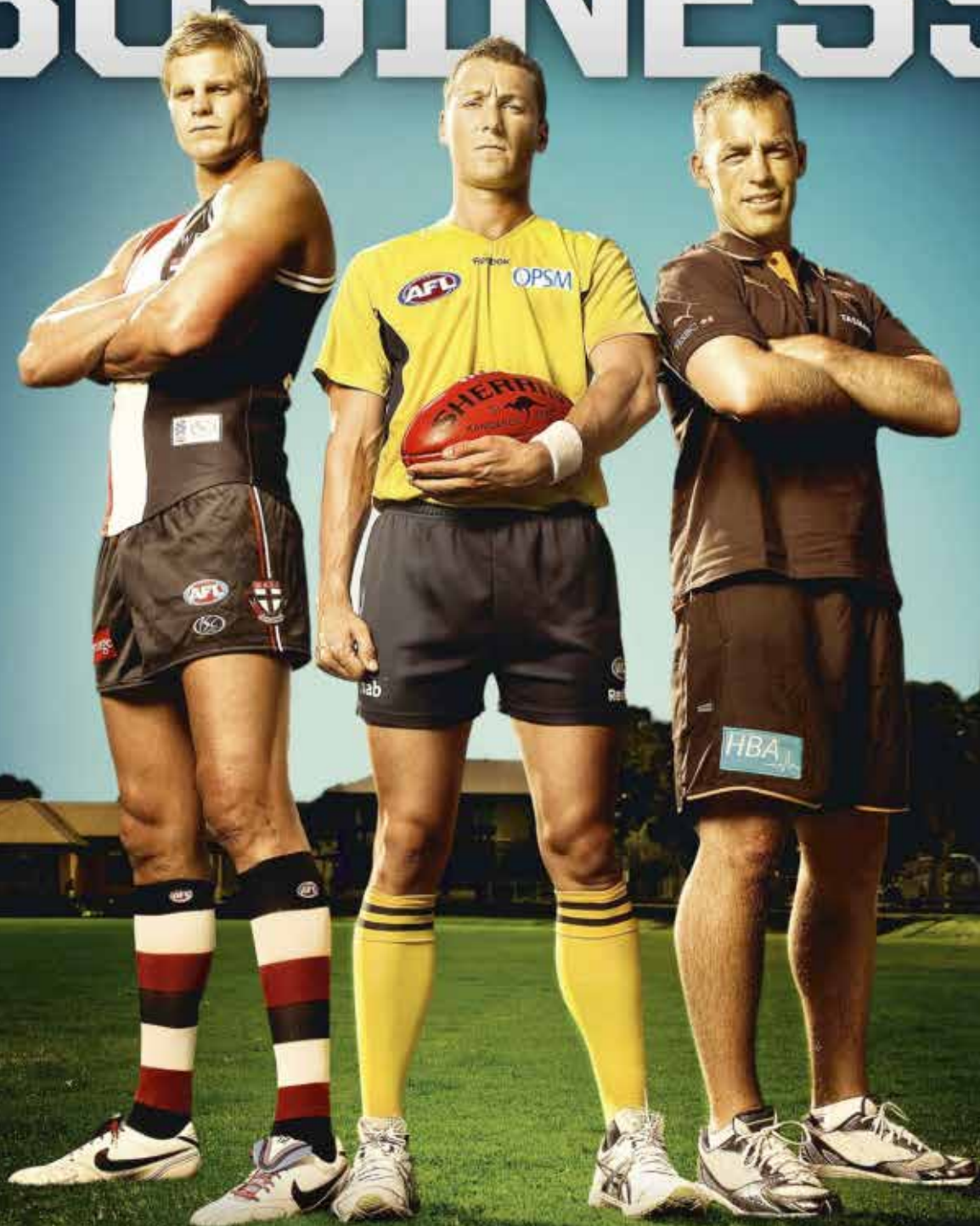

# CODES OF CONDUCT

## PARENTS

- Abide by the rules and conditions as set down by the DRJFL and UTJFC

- Remember, children play sport for their enjoyment, not yours
- Encourage children to participate, do not force them
- Turn defeat into victory by helping your child work towards skill improvement and good sportsmanship
- Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game
- Teach your children that honest effort is as important as victory so that the result of each game is accepted without due disappointment
- Remember that children learn best by example - applaud good play by both your team and by members of the opposite team
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities
- Do not abuse or criticise official's decisions and teach children likewise
- Support and show appreciation of volunteer coaches, officials and administrators as without them, your child could not participate
- Speak with your child's coach if you or your child has have a problem, before approaching a member of the committee
- Support your Club officials in maintaining the highest standard of behaviour both on and off the field for betterment of the League and your family

## PLAYERS & COACHES

- Play by the rules
- Never argue with an umpire or official
- Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials, umpires or other players or provoking an opponent is neither acceptable nor permitted in any sport
- Work equally hard for yourself and your team
- Be a good sport - always shake hands with your opponent/s before and after the game, saying thanks to them and the umpire/s
- Treat all players as you would like to be treated
- Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another teammate or opponent
- Play for the fun of it, not just to please anyone else

# DRJFL Injured Player Policy

**As a procedure for injured players, Clubs need to be reminded that when a player is injured -**

Team mates are not to try to get an injured player up by any means.

Trainers are to be deployed immediately from both teams.

The trainer is the only one that decides what happens next.

Time has to be taken to assess the players injury.

If the injured player is unable to walk themselves off the ground, a stretcher must be called.

If a player is unconscious, or there is a suspicion of head or spinal injuries they are not to be moved off the ground at all.

If a trainer calls for an ambulance to be rung, it should be the hosting club ringing the ambulance and putting a procedure in place to greet the ambulance on arrival and assist in opening gates to allow access onto the ground.

**Nobody is to override a trainer** as to the removal of an injured player off the ground. The Trainer has the final say as to the well being of all players.

Clubs are to ensure that they have blankets available to keep any injured child if warm if necessary.

The umpire is to be notified immediately of the injured player and the game is to be stopped while the player is assessed.

**The picking up of smaller children to remove them from the ground is to stop.**

We are all volunteers and it is only a game of football. We have recently had some major injuries and we are to learn by these incidents.

**We have been told by a mica paramedic that we are not, repeat not, to remove any player off the ground with suspected head or spinal injuries. This is a guide that needs to be followed and enforced to protect the safety of all the players and coaching staff.**

I recommend that all clubs and secretaries print this off, give a copy to each team coaching staff, print it in their magazines and put it on their notice board so that everyone including parents know what is to happen. The trainers should know exactly what they are to do.

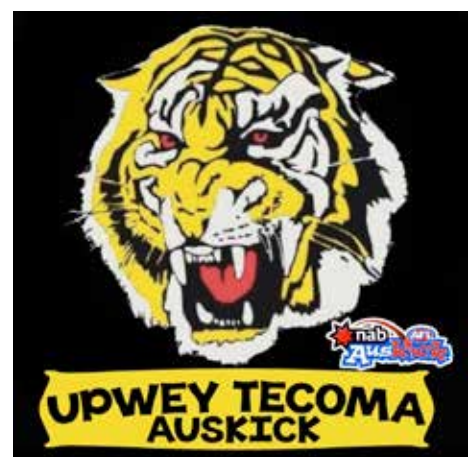
