NPL TRIALS PROCESS AND MINI ROOS U10/U11 COME AND TRY SESSIONS.

Moreland Zebras will be conducting the following trials,

- Trials for ages U12 – U18 for its NPL squads
- Mini Roo's teams U10 & 11 teams.

Trial Assessments will be under the guidance of Technical director **Riccardo Marchioli** and the 2015 coaching staff.

Squad Numbers:

- NPL Squads will be 16 players
- Mini Roos will be 13 players for U10 & U11 squads per team – 3 Teams per Age Group.

How will the trial Process Work: U12 –U18 NPL

All age groups have specified trial dates and times set out. All Players are required to trial for the first two sessions. After the completion of trial 1&2 a short list of players will be announced and players invited for trial 3&4. After the completion of trial 3&4 the squads will be announced. Notification of 1st round offers for positions will be made by 30th November.

To fulfil your selection and take up the offer a deposit is expected to be made.
