WRFL COACHES WANT REWARD FOR EFFORT

WESTERN Region Football League coach Anthony Eames says he has been impressed with the skills and commitment shown by senior players over the past four weeks.

senior squad began with a team of 53 talented individuals, but after much deliberation the coaching panel, led by Eames, have decided on a final squad of 26 players that will go head-to-head with the Ballarat FNL today.

The senior squad features players from 10 clubs across the competition, with Spotswood star Murray Boyd named captain.

Eames said the team was fired up for the WorkSafe AFL Victoria Community Championships match and was ready to represent the league with passion and pride.

"We are confident we have put the best side out on the park, we have prepared well and we are hoping to get rewarded on game day," he said.

"We are not worried about who is out, it is who is in that we are worrying about.

"These players have committed to the program and they have communicated to the coaching panel their excitement for this game.

"We have done a lot of work and we are hoping that equates to a win on Saturday."

Veteran of the Interleague side and one of the stars of the competition Tim Jenkins said playing Interleague footy was always an honour.

"It is a chance to represent the league, you don't know when it will end, so you have to make the most of it and enjoy getting out there," he said.

"I haven't had the chance to play much finals footy, that is a priority, but getting the chance to do this is a pretty good experience and something you look back on after you retire as a good time."

The two-time Barry Priest medallist will be joined by a fellow league best and fairest winner, Werribee Districts favourite Matt Dean.

Dean said playing the Interleague game was something he looked forward to each year.

"Coming from the amateur competition we had rep footy each year and it is something I really aspire to play," he said.

"It is the highest level of football you can play without having the commitment of playing VFL."

Dean, the captain of the Tigers, said the wide open spaces of Whitten Oval would suit the players in the WRFL side.

WRFL team-mate and Altona star Joel Magnabosco also joins the side.

The 28-year-old returns to the WRFL after spending two seasons with Echuca in the Goulburn Valley Football League.

"I wanted to come back home and not have to travel each week, so it's good to be back at Altona," Magnabosco said.

"The past two years I have been playing elsewhere and the opportunity came up to play again and I am really wrapt that I can play in this game."

Meanwhile, the Under-19 team has also finalised its final squad of 25 for the match with Ballarat.

A host of the WRFL's most brightest young stars have been named in the squad, with Nick Ryan from Spotswood given the honour of captaining the team.

"We are really happy with the boys that have been picked," he said.

"They have all attended training and showed a willingness to be a part of the representative side.

"We are all now looking forward to playing."

BOYD TO LEAD FROM THE FRONT

WHEN Senior Interleague coach Anthony Eames called Murray Boyd after training, Boyd didn't know what to expect.

Eames had called to tell him he was going to be named captain of the Western Region Football League for 2016.

The Spotswood star admits he was a little surprised to get the call-up considering the likes of Tom Langlands, Matt Dean and Tim Jenkins were in the senior side, but said it is a role he was looking forward to fulfilling.

"It's a huge honour," he said.

"I am very proud to represent the league.

"There is a lot of players in the side I have played with and against over the years, so it is great to be leading the league to battle with Ballarat."

Eames, who has previously coached Boyd said he was a great footballer and a terrific young man.

"I know he is not an outwardly spoken or loud person, he is someone who leads by example," he said.

"When he does speak people listen.

"He has a lot of respect from all clubs and opposition players in our competition and also a lot of players in other leagues outside the WRFL respect him as well."

Boyd, who is also the captain of Spotswood, said what he enjoys most about being captain was the ability to mentor some of the younger players.

He said there was quite a few players in the rep squad he had played with previously and said his main focus was to guide them during training and then on game day, let the footy do the talking.

"The guys are feeling buoyant, we have had four training sessions now and had the jumper presentation on Sunday," Boyd said.

"It is an exciting week and we are really feeling confident."

Boyd has had an outstanding career to date, and has a long list of achievements.

He played his junior football with Spotswood, before Carlton selected him with pick 18 in the AFL Rookie Draft in 2002.

He didn't play a game with Carlton, but went on to play with the Northern Blues and Williamstown in the VFL.

Boyd made the switch to the Essendon District Football League a few years later.

He said his best footy moment came in 2009 and 2010 when Maribyrnong Park claimed back-to-back premierships.

"I was lucky enough to win a premiership with Williamstown in the reserves and then with Maribyrnong Park, I haven't quite got one with Spotswood, I missed their run, but hopefully I can win one soon," Boyd said.

The 30-year old decided to go back to his family at Spotswood in 2013 and since his return he has been one of the standout players of the WRFL.

He won the club best and fairest award in 2015, was named in the WRFL's Team of the Year and won the SEN MVP award.

Boyd was also one of the players who was involved in last year's Metro Championships loss to the Eastern Football League.

He said he hopes the WRFL can change that loss to a win today.

"You want to do the best you can for the league," Boyd said.

"We really want to show the football community that we are a quality league.

"We matched it with Eastern for a half and they overpowered us in the second half, we are hoping to turn the tables this year."

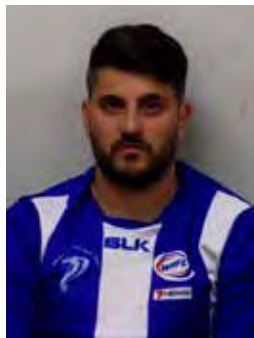

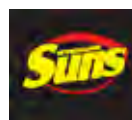

AFL UMPIRES SHARE TIPS WITH WRFL YOUNGSTERS

LAST week was the AFL's Community Umpiring Round and as part of this initiative four AFL umpires were sent out to speak to WRFL umpires at Scovell Reserve.

They were Sam Hay (field), Jason Moore (boundary), Andrew Stevens (field) and Steve Williams (goal).

Besides the 45 minute talk that was facilitated by Mark Westgarth, two other important things happened. Firstly, one of the AFL umpires turned up early so that he could be involved with the usual training out on the track.

There were opportunities for casual introductions, to have brief conversations on a one-on-one basis, gain a tip or two and generally rub shoulders with one who has made it to the top level of umpiring. This individual AFL umpire even initiated some of the skill drills.

Secondly, after the evening talk, the AFL umpires didn't rush off, but they stayed around to talk to individuals, have a quick photograph taken with some of the budding WRFL young umpires and again share some of their experiences in the AFL.

During the talk each of the AFL umpires was asked to briefly talk about their career pathways.

All had started in local leagues and worked their way up over the years.

Their commitment was obvious due to the amount of training that they do each week for virtually 12 months of the year.

This was also reflected in the fact that three of them had moved from other states to ensure that they could continue at the AFL level.

Each of them agreed that there were many sacrifices that they had to make in order to maintain their fitness, remain at the top of their game and be available for games whenever and wherever.

It was stated that the enjoyment, the pride and the on-going achievement in umpiring at such a level was a great motivating force.

It did appear that all the WRFL umpires who were able to attend the training and/or the meeting enjoyed the visit.

It will be interesting to see who will be the next WRFL umpire to make it to the AFL level.

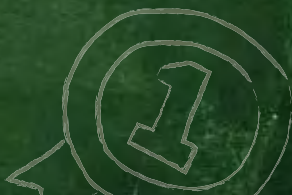
