

WRFL SHARES IMPORTANT WHITE RIBBON MESSAGE

OVER the next few weeks the Western Region Football League will be working with White Ribbon to raise awareness to end violence against women.

Violence against women is a serious issue in Australia, with on average, 52 women killed per year by a current or former partner.

You may think this isn't an issue many are confronted

with in our community, but last year alone there was 9000 reported incidents of violence against women in Melbourne's inner west.

That is a staggeringly high number of incidents in our own backyard.

It is time, as a league and as a community, we make a stand against domestic violence.

In the lead-up to the WRFL's White Ribbon Round on July 16 and 17, the league will share information about the work White Ribbon does in the community as well as educate the league's players, coaches, officials, volunteers and supporters about what you can do to address this serious issue.

In this issue of the Footy Record we learn about what White Ribbon is and in particular the White Ribbon Night, an event that aims to raise awareness and funds to end men's violence against women.

The league has also been working on a special White

Ribbon project with players from across our league. Stay tuned to the WRFL website next week for more.

Also this weekend is Multicultural Round - a dedicated AFL round that honours and celebrates the multicultural players and communities who are involved in our great game.

The Western Region Football League is a very diverse league, with players from different backgrounds coming together to play footy.

Whether it is a sport you have grown up with or it is something you have come to love, footy has always been a great way to connect with others.

Throughout the state there is a number of multicultural programs which encourage people to play footy.

A new program is the Werribee based AFL Victoria Diversity Squad, which is run by the Werribee Football Club's Chris Gallagher.

The new initiative aims to help multicultural people fast-track their football development as well as provide a pathway for them to pursue footy at a higher level.

It is a great program that will only get bigger and better in years to come.

GRETO HITS 400TH GAME MILESTONE

SUNSHINE Heights legend Robert Greto will play his 400th game today.

The proud and passionate Dragons playing-coach, who has earned multiple club best and fairest awards, will lead his team in their match against the Wyndham Suns.

Greto is not one to make a fuss over milestones, however, president Vince Sposato said the achievement shouldn't go unnoticed, saying he has had a huge impact on the club.

"I could go on forever about Robbie," Sposato said. "He is a highly respected person at our footy club."

"I approached him to coach in 2015 and at first he refused, just because family and work commitments stood in the way.

"But he eventually said yes and to be honest he has kept the doors open at Sunshine Heights.

"He has played juniors right through to senior football at the club, he captained the side, is century goal kicker, is a life member of the club, now coach and will become a 400-game player.

"His record speaks for itself."

Greto kicked 108 goals in 2007 and in the following year captained the club to its first senior premiership since 1998.

Sposato said the star player didn't play footy for the accolades, he plays because he loves footy and he loves Sunshine Heights.

"He is a family man and a quality individual, who wears his heart on his sleeve," he said.

Sposato said he hoped his club, who is currently in fifth position on the Division 3 ladder, could do it for Greto this weekend.

"Our aim is to make finals this year," he said.

"We have come a long way as a club in the past two years.

"We have improved a hell of a lot on and off field. There are a lot of passionate Dragon people who want this club to succeed and I am confident as club president that we will.

"I really hope we can get a win on the board for Robbie this weekend."



BOUNDARY UMPIRE MARKS SIGNIFICANT MILESTONE

RECENTLY the prolific AFL boundary umpire in Darren Wilson retired after officiating in over 400 AFL games. This included an astonishing 12 consecutive AFL grand finals.

Darren is only one of a handful of umpires to have umpired over the magical 400 game mark at the top level, however he is the first boundary umpire to reach that total.

Just a few weeks prior to that another umpire achieved a remarkable milestone.

AFL goal umpire, David Dixon, became the record holder for the most VFL/AFL games as a goal umpire with 338 games.

In 1987 when David finished playing junior football he was invited by the Footscray District Football League (now the WRFL) to take up umpiring.

He umpired for seven years on our local grounds as a boundary umpire officiating in several open age grand finals before switching to waving flags.

A couple of years later he was invited into 'town' and the rest is history.

David's advice for up and coming umpires was to work hard and you will reap the awards.

"You can't just maintain to your level. You have to continuously improve and reinvent yourself, just as players and coaches do, to ensure that you are at your best once you walk onto the field," he said.

Not everyone who takes up umpiring is fortunate to be able to officiate for such lengthy periods of time.

At Scovell Reserve the WRFL umpires have a small honour board listing those who have umpired for 30 years or more.

Out of the thousands who have blown whistles, run boundaries or waved flags, the list is indeed short.

It is interesting to ponder whether any of our present running umpires will still be involved in 30 years' time.

Umpires are tending to start much younger now than in previous decades. Maybe that small honour board will need extending?

Finally, a reminder that the umpires' association is organising a Farewell (to Scovell Reserve) Reunion of past and present members on Saturday August 6 at 7 pm at Scovell Reserve.
