OUR ASSOCIATION AND 2016-17 FINAL SERIES AWARDS NIGHT

The Manjimup Amateur Basketball Association (Association) continues to promote the health and wellbeing of our community by delivering basketball programs for participants from 6 years of age to over 60 years!

Our Association is an extension of the community and our volunteers, the lifeline of our Association. Each week we have a large number of volunteers who step forward to develop our junior players by coaching and/or umpiring both the junior and senior competitions. Our Association continues to grow its JUMPS (Junior Umpiring Program) and providing opportunities for further accreditation.

- ❖ Our 2016 Aussie Hoops program held in Term 3 over an eight week period enabled our most junior players to learn basketball in a fun and safe environment. It includes warm up drills, skill activities and modified games for 6-10 year olds. With 134 participants, our program is gaining momentum!
- ❖ November 2016 saw our 10 Association Representative Teams (under 13 – 18s) participate in the Regional Championships held in Eaton, Busselton and Bunbury. Despite the population differences, our Association held its own with the likes of Bunbury, Eaton and Australind as a prelude to the Country Championships.
- ❖ Our summer competition commenced in October 2016 with 273 senior players and 235 junior players pounding the boards and testing their defensive skill set.
 - 6 A grade Men and 10 B grade Men's teams
 - 3 A grade, 5 AR grade and 12 B grade Women's teams.
 - 5 teams U12, 5 teams U14, 5 teams U16 and 6 teams U19 in Junior Men
 - 2 teams U12, 6 teams U14, 6 teams U16 and 4 teams U19 in Junior Women
- ❖ Promising junior player Joshua Ladhams was selected to represent Western Australian in the U16 Country Men's Team in 2016 and Archie Hall has been selected to represent WA in the U18 State Country Men's team who will travel to Queensland in April 2017. Braden Wilson has also been selected as a reserve for the U18 State team.
- ❖ Adele East and Dana East were both selected to represent WA in the U/15's Country Women's development team travelling to Melbourne in January 2016. Adele East was also selected to represent WA in the U/16 State Country Women's team at the Australian Junior championships held in July 2016 in Melbourne. Both Adele and Dana have been selected in the State Performance Programme and are now in the selection process

where a team will be appointed at the end of March 2017 to represent WA in the U16 State country women's team at the Australian Junior Championships to be held in Perth later this year.

- ❖ February 2017 will see our Association Representative Teams participate in the Western Australian Country Championships, held at the WA Basketball Centre in Perth. Our Teams go head to head with full strength city opposition, teams loaded with WABL players; each year we nominate our Teams in the highest grade and are represented by enthusiastic players and supporters. Months of training put to the test (with some city fun thrown in along the way)!
- ❖ You may have spotted our *NEW* Association Timberwolves Polo shirts out and about. Players and spectators can purchase one of these shirts to show support from our Property Officer or the stadium office.

Next month the Association will be concluding the summer season with *grand final* games and trophy presentations. Due to various events imposing on our original finals dates, we have had to split our finals as follows:
