This year the Non-Competitive Juniors will begin a 16 round season on the 27th of April.

Competitive Juniors

The Competitive Juniors will begin on the 6th of April, with the first part of the season being a League Cup lasting 4 weeks, which will also double as a final grading decision process. After the League Cup, there will be a 14 Round Season with a 3 week final series following.

Pre-season training for our competitive junior players in ages U12, U14 & U16s has commenced for 2019.

Group training will be held within each age group until the teams are finalised.

Once teams have been chosen, the players will be advised of their coach, training night, training time and pitch.
