2019 JUNIOR REPRESENTATIVE TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

TIMING RULES

- Game time: Four (4) Ten (10) minute quarters
- Warm-up period: Minimum Two (2) minute
- Quarter time, Half time & Three Quarter time: One (1) minute
- Time Outs: One (1) per team per quarter (30 second duration)
- Clock stops on: Each whistle during the last three (3) minutes of the final quarter.
- Draws are permitted

ZONE DEFENCE POLICY

Zone defence is NOT permitted in the following age groups:

- (a) Under 12
- (b) Under 14

THE FOLLOWING STEPS WILL BE USED DURING THIS TOURNAMENT:

STEP 1: Team manager or coach to raise the issue of defence with the venue supervisor.

STEP 2: If it is deemed to be a zone defence, a warning is to be issued to the coach.

STEP 3: If zone defence continues after a warning is given, a technical foul shall be issued on the coach.

SIN BIN

Players or team officials receiving a technical foul will be penalised in the normal manner with the added penalty of the player/team official being disqualified from the court for a period of Five (5) playing minutes. The scorer will record the time the penalty was imposed on the scoresheet/laptop and advise the team when the player/team official is able to return to the game. Any subsequent technical fouls for players or team officials will result in disqualification of the offending person/s.

BALLS

- Each team must supply their own warm up ball.
- Male games a size 6 ball will be used for all U12, U14 games, U16, U18 games will use a size 7.
- Female games will always use a size 6 ball.
- The best warm-up ball will be used as the match ball.
- No responsibility is taken by organisers for loss of team basketballs.

FIRST AID

- All teams are to provide their own First Aid.

GENERAL

- Teams MUST CHECK the tournament website prior to their first game, and regularly during the tournament for alterations to draws, times, games, etc.
- All stadiums used during this Tournament have NO swinging on rings or nets. Doing so imposes an immediate ban from the Tournament
- Team registration fee is non-refundable, excluding when Geelong United Basketball removes competitions due to insufficient entries
- It is the responsibility of interstate teams to provide their own sports insurance
- The Tournament Committee reserves the right to combine A and B grades, or to cancel any division or grade if insufficient entries are received
