Association information

Championship dates

The 2021 Championships will be held on the following dates:

- Senior Country Championships 30th & 31st January 2021, St Clair Rec Centre YMCA
- Junior Country Championships U14 and U18, 6th – 8th March 2021, venues TBC
- Junior Country Championships U12 and U16, 20th & 21st March 2021, venues TBC

Registration and By-laws

- All registrations must be completed online
- Please ensure you are familiar with the [Country Championship Bylaws](#) and/or all other By-laws

Fees

The **team nomination fees** to cover the expenses relating to hosting the Championships are:

- Senior Country Championships; \$300.00 (incl. GST) per team
- Junior Country Championships; \$310.00 (incl. GST) per team

The **fees and reimbursements for Referee nomination** are as follows:

- No referee nominated with the team - \$200 fee
- A non-country Referee nominated with the team - \$125 fee
- Country Referee nominated with the team - \$50 reimbursement
- Refer below for Referee nomination requirements

Grades

Nominations will be accepted for the following grades:

- Seniors: A, B, C – men, A and B women
- Juniors: Div 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5 – boys and girls

Teams may be re-graded or grades combined at the discretion of SACBCI once nominations close.

Tax invoices

A tax invoice will be issued to the Association on receipt of a nomination.

Team Nominations

- Senior Country Championships; team nominations close on **11th December 2020**
- U12/14/16/18 Junior Country Championships; team nominations close **8th January 2021**.

Team Nominations will be collected via an online [Team Nomination Form](#) to ensure all required information is received. Select 'New team Registration'

Team Sheets

All teams will be required to complete a [Team Sheet](#) and forward this to SA Country by the dates listed below. If changes to the Team Lists occur after this date SA Country need to be notified immediately.

- **18th January 2021** – U12/14/16/18 Junior Country Championships

Player, Coach and Team manager Registrations

- Senior Country Championships; player registrations close on **11th January 2021**
- U12/14/16/18 Junior Country Championships; player registrations close on **12th February 2021**

Once team nominations have closed, associations will be provided with a registration link and Team Code. This will need to be used to register all players, team managers and coaches online. Player, team manager and coach registration will be collected online to ensure all required information is received.

Referees

Referee registration will be online. Please ensure you identify and circulate the form below to the nominal number of Referees required as per the number of nominated teams **and also** for any referees looking for development opportunities.

The Championships are a great way for referees to experience rapid development and be involved with other experienced referees and referee coaches.

Referees are required to be available to officiate at any venue in accordance with the appropriate grade, division or age group of the nominated Referee for the duration of the tournament. Referees will be paid by direct credit post tournament. Please ensure both coaches and referees are registered with the association to cover insurance liabilities.

Note that it is a requirement of the nomination process that the Referees register and advise of their availability to validate your team nominations. The program is linked to the fixture and can accommodate a request to not clash with specified teams or times during the Championships.

The required number of Referees is as follows:

1-4 teams nominated = 1 referee per team

5-6 teams nominated = 4 referees

7-9 teams nominated = 5 referees

10+ teams nominated = 6 referees

Failure to correctly nominate may incur penalties at the discretion of the organising committee.

Playing uniforms

An alternative playing uniform **must** be provided in the event of colour clashes, please refer to this section of the Bylaws for advice on non provision of an alternative playing uniform.

First Aid

Each team will need to provide First Aid requirements. SA Country will ensure a qualified sports medicine trainer will be present at each venue – note that they are not able to supply tape to all players, please ensure you provide tape.

Fines and other fees

Forfeit fines are to be paid by the nominating Association if a team withdraws after the fixture is created. Nomination fee will not be refunded once the fixture has been completed.
